

ज्वलितनयन mfn. (-नः-ना-ने) Fiery-eyed, looking angrily or fiercely. E. ज्वलित, and नयन the eye ; also ज्वलितचक्षुस्, ज्वलितनेत्र, &c.
 ज्वलिन् mfn. (-ली-लिनी-लि) 1. Burning, flaming. 2. Shining. E. ज्वल, and इनि aff.
 ज्वाल mfn. (-लः-ली-ल) Burning, blazing. mf. (लः-ला) Flame, blaze. f. (-ला) Burnt rice. E. ज्वल् to blaze, affix च्, fem. affix टाप् or डीप्.
 ज्वालाग्नि m. (-ग्निः) Flame. E. ज्वाल, and अग्नि fire.
 ज्वालजिह्वु m. (-ह्वुः) AGNI, or fire. E. ज्वाला, and जिह्वु a tongue ; whose tongue is flame.
 ज्वालामुखी f. (-खी) A place where subterraneous fires break forth ; an object of veneration to the Hindus ; a celebrated Jwalamukhi exists in Punjab, to which pilgrimages are made ; the soil abounding with carburetted hydrogen, which takes fire upon coming in contact with the external air ; otherwise vents being made, a light is applied to the orifice, and flame being kindled, is fed by the stream of gas that escapes. The tongue of PARVATI is said to have fallen at this place. E. ज्वाला flame, and मुख chief, principal, fem. affix डीप्.
 ज्वालिन् mfn. (-ली-लिनी-लि) 1. Flaming, blazing. 2. An Epithet of Siva, E. ज्वल्, and इनि aff.

अ The ninth consonant of the Deva Nagara alphabet ; the aspirate of the preceding letter, and corresponding in power to Jh.
 अ mfn. (अः-आ-अं) 1. Asleep, sleeping. 2. Lost, destroyed. m. (अः) 1. A name of VRIHASPATI, preceptor of the gods. 2. A name of the chief of the Daityas or demons. 3. Soud or a sort of sound like the splashing of water, or the clanging of cymbals, jangling, clanging, &c. 4. High wind. 5. A stray, a thing lost or mislaid. 6. Playing a tune, beating time. f. (आ) The descent of a cascade, a water fall. E. अट् to collect, affix ड.
 अङ्कार m. (-रः) A low inarticulate sound, as the buzzing of bees, &c. E. अ, and कार making. ङ-चञ् ।
 अञ्जन n. (-नं) An indistinct noise, like the jangling of metallic ornaments, a ringing, a rattling, &c.
 अञ्जा f. (-ञ्जा) 1. Wind, wind and rain, a hurricane, a gale. 2. A sharp clanging sound, jangling. 3. Raining in large drops. 4. A stray, any thing lost. अमिति ज्वाला अटति अट-ड ।
 अञ्जानिल m. (-लः) Wind with rain, a high wind in the rainy season, a typhoon or the sort of tempest frequent during the south-west monsoon. E. अञ्जा heavy rain, and अनिल wind ; also अञ्जामकत्, &c.
 अञ्जावात m. (-तः) Wind with rain, a storm, a squall. E. अञ्जा heavy rain, and वात wind.
 अट् r. 1st. cl. (अटति) To clot, to be entangled, (as hair :) see जट्. E. भू-पर-सक-सेट् ।
 अटा f. (-टा) A plant, (Flacourtia cataphracta.) E. अट् to entangled, affix च्च.
 अटि m. (-टिः) A small tree, a shrub, a bush. E. जट् to be entangled, इन् Unadi aff.
 अटिति ind. Quickly, speedily, instantly. E. अटि entangling, confusing, affix इन् क्तिन् ; also जटिति.
 अमत्कार m. (-रः) The clanging of metallic ornaments, &c. E. अमत् imitative sound, &c. कार making.
 अम (ड) अमृ r. 1st. cl. (अमति) To eat ; see जमृ, &c. E. भू-प-सक-सेट् ।
 अम्य mf. (-म्यः-म्या) Jumping, springing, plunging. E. अम् imitative sound, and पत् to fall, affix ड्,

अम्प्याक m. (-कः) A monkey or ape. E. अम्य, and अक to go. अम्येन आकायति आ + कै-क। वानरे ।
 अम्प्यारु m. (-रुः) A monkey, an ape. E. अम्य plunging, and अश् to go, डण् aff.
 अम्प्याश्लिन् m. (-शी) A kingfisher. E. अम्य plunging, and अश् to eat, affix श्लिन्.
 अम्प्यिन् m. (-म्यी) A monkey, an ape. E. अम्य springing, इनि aff.
 अमर m. (-रः) f. (-रा or -रिः-री) A cascade, a water-fall. f. (-री) A river. E. अम् to waste or decay, affix अप्, fem. affix टाप्, इन् or डीप् ; also निभार.
 अमर्च r. 6th cl. (अमर्चति) 1. To say. 2. To blame, to abuse or menace ; also अमर्च अर्च, &c. E. तुदा० प० सक० सेट् ।
 अमर्छ r. 6th cl. (अमर्छति) 1. To say. 2. To blame, to abuse or menace ; also अमर्छ. E. तुदा-प-सक-सेट् ।
 अमर्ज r. 6th cl. (अमर्जति) 1. To say, to speak. 2. To censure, to blame. E. तुदा-पर-सक-सेट् ।
 अमर्क r. 1st and 10th cls. (अमर्कति अमर्कयति-ते) 1. To speak or say. 2. To censure or reprove. r. 1st cl. (अमर्कति) To kill or hurt.
 अमर्कर mf. (-रः-री) A sort of drum. m. (-रः) 1. The Kaliyuga, the present Yuga or age of the world. 2. The name of a river. 3. A cane-staff. 4. A cymbal f. (-रा) A whore, n. (-रः) A sound as of splashing or dropping. E. अमर्क an imitative sound like that of water splashing, &c. and र what makes, from रा with ड affix, or अमर्क to censure, and करच् Unadi aff.
 अमर्करक m. (-कः) The Kaliyug. E. कन् added to the preceding.
 अमर्करीक m. (-कः) 1. The body. 2. A country. 3. A picture. E. अमर्क to injure or destroy, ईकन् affix, and र inserted.
 अमलज्जला f. (-ला) The flapping of an elephant's ears, or loose breasts, &c. the word is considered as merely imitative of the noise made.
 अमलरी f. (-री) 1. A sort of drum. 2. A curl. E. अमल imitative sound, र from रा to get or make, affixes ड and डोप् ; also अमलरी and अमली.
 अमला f. (-ला) 1. A daughter, a girl. 2. Sunshine, splendour, brilliant or glistering light. 3. A cricket ; also आला.
 अमलि f. (-लिः) The areca nut.
 अमल्ल m. (-ल्लः) A prize fighter, a cudgel player, a man of a tribe following such a profession ; one of the degraded classes, being sprung from the outcaste Kshetriya. E. जल् to surround or embrace, ल् added, and ज changed to ल्ल.
 अमल्लक n. (-कः) Cymbals. E. अमल्ल imitative sound, a clash, and क what emits, from कै to sound, affix ड्.
 अमल्लकण्ड m. (-ण्डः) A pigeon. E. अमल्ल imitative sound, and कण्ड a throat.
 अमल्लरी f. (-री) 1. A sort of drum. 2. A curl, a lock of hair : see अमलरी. 3. A ball, &c. of perfumed substances used for cleaning the hair. 4. Moisture. 5. Purity.
 अमल्लिका f. (-का) 1. Light, splendour, lustre. 2. A rag or cloth used for applying colour or perfumes. 3. Dirt brought off the body by rubbing it with perfumes. E. अमर्क खल् पूषी० ।
 अमल्लि f. (-ल्लि) A kind of drum : see अमलरी.
 अमल्लोल m. (-लः) A ball or protuberance at the lower end of a spindle.
 अमर 1st. cl. (अमरति-ते) 1. To kill or hurt. 2. To take. 3. To put on, to wear. E. स्वा-पर-सक-सेट् । यद्गणे पिषाने च भू-उभ-सक-सेट् ।
 अमष m. (-षः) 1. A fish. 2. The sign "Pisces" of the Zodiac. 3. Heat, warmth. 4. A forest, a thicket. f. (-षा) A plant, (Hedysarum lagopodioides.) n. (-षं) Waste land. E. अष् to injure, affix कर्मणि च ।
 अमषकेतन m. (-नः) A name of KANDĀRPA. E. अमष a fish, and केतन a banner, who bears a fish on his banner.
 अमषाड m. (-डः) A name of Kandārpā अमष, E. a fish and अड a mark or symbol.
 अमषाशन m. (-नः) The gangetic porpoise. E. अमष fish, and अशन food.
