 प्रमिताचरा f. (-रा) 1. A species of Jagati' metre. 2. The name of the commentary on Muburta chinta'mani.
 प्रमिति f. (-तिः) 1. True knowledge derived from senses, inference, analogy or information. 2. Measuring; इ. प्र before, मा to measure, (by which,) क्तिन् aff., and the radical vowel changed.
 प्रमीठ mfn. (-ठः-ठा-ठं) 1. Thick. 2. Passed, passed as urine. इ. प्र before, मिद् to sprinkle, aff. क् ।
 प्रमीषत् mfn. (-षन्-षती-षत्) 1. Overcoming, subduing. 2. Injuring, killing. इ. प्र before, षी to hurt or kill, षट् aff.

 प्रमूढ mfn. (-ढः-ढा-ढं) 1. A fool, foolish, stupid. 2. Bewildered, deceived. इ. प्र, and मूढ a fool. [sign of sense].

 प्रयत्नम् mfn. (-न्मा-न्मा-न्म) Devout, pious, of a holy spirit. इ. प्रयत्, and प्रयत्न n. (-नं) 1. Continued or persevering effort, exertion. 2. Act, action. 3. A celebrated place of pilgrimage, the confluence of the Ganges and Jamuna', with the supposed subterraneous addition of the Saraswati'; the modern Alla'ha'ba'd. The term in composition is applied to many places of reputed sanctity, situated at the confluence of two rivers, as De'va-Praya'ga, Rudra-Praya'ga, Karn'a-Praya'ga, and Nanda-Praya'ga, in the Hima'laya' mountains, which with Praya'ga or Alla'ha'ba'd, constitute the five principal places so termed. 3. A name of INDRA. 4.
