

सञ्जक m. (-कः) 1. A bed, a beadstead. 2. A platform, a scaffold. 3. A stand for holding fire. E. कन् added to the preceding.

सञ्जकाश्रय m. (-यः) A bug. E. सञ्जक a bed, and आश्रय abode.

सञ्जमण्डप m. (-पः) A sort of temporary open shed, a platform erected for particular ceremonies, as marriages, &c. E. सञ्ज a scaffold, and मण्डप a temporary hall.

सञ्ज r. 10th cl. (सञ्जयति) 1. To sound, 2. To clean, to purify.

सञ्जर mf. (-र-री) 1. A pearl. 2. A compound pedicle. 3. A sort of plant, commonly Tilaka. E. सञ्ज beautiful, ऋ to go or be, aff. ञप्, deriv. irr.; or सञ्ज-श्चरच् ।

सञ्जरि f. (-रि-री) 1. A compound pedicle, a fruit or flower-stalk. 2. A large pearl. 3. A plant, commonly Tilaka. 4. A line. 5. A creeper. 6. The holy-basil. mf. (-रि-री) A shoot, a sprout. E. सञ्ज beautiful, ऋ to go, or be, aff. इ, deriv. irr., ङीप् optionally added.

सञ्जरिचामर n. (-र) A fan-like sprout. [इतच् aff.]

सञ्जरित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Mounted on a stalk, (a bud, &c.) E. सञ्जर and सञ्जरिनम् m. (-म्) The Vetasa plant.

सञ्जा f. (-जा) 1. A compound pedicle; see the last. 2. A she-goat. 3. A creeper. E. सञ्ज to sound, aff. ञच् ।

सञ्जि f. (-ञ्जि-ञ्जी) A compound pedicle; also सञ्जरी ।

सञ्जिका f. (-का) A harlot, a whore. E. सञ्जि-खु-लु-टाप् ऋत इत्स्म् ।

सञ्जिकला f. (-ला) The plantain, (Musa sapientum.) E. सञ्जि a foot-stalk, and फल fruit.

सञ्जिमन् n. (म) Beauty, elegance. E. सञ्ज handsome, इमनिच् aff.

सञ्जिष्ठा f. (-ष्ठा) Bengal madder, a plant used in medicine, and in dying, (Rubia Manjith, Rox.) E. सञ्ज beautiful, स्था to stay or be, क् aff., deriv. irr.; or सञ्जि a compound pedicle, and स्थ aff.

सञ्जिष्ठाराम m. (-राम) 1. The dye of madder. 2. An attachment as durable as the colour of the Indian madder, permanent attachment, (figuratively.) E. सञ्जिष्ठा and राम colour.

सञ्जीर n. (-र) An ornament for the feet or toes. m. (-रः) A post, round which passes the string that works the stick of a churn. E. सञ्ज् to sound, aff. ईरन्; also with कन् added सञ्जीरक ।

सञ्जील m. (-लः) 1. A village, inhabited chiefly by washermen. 2. An anklet. E. सञ्ज् to sound, ईरन् aff. and र changed to ल ।

सञ्जु mfn. (-ञ्जुः-ञ्जुः-ञ्जुः) Beautiful, pleasing, agreeable. E. सञ्ज् to clean, aff. उन् ।

सञ्जुकेभिन् mfn. (-श्री-श्री-श्री) Beautiful-haired. m. (-श्री) A name of KRISHN'A, or VISHN'U in that form. E. सञ्ज् beautiful, केश hair, इनि aff.

सञ्जुगमना f. (-ना) A goose. E. सञ्ज् beautiful, elegant, and गमन gait.

सञ्जुगुञ्ज m. (-ञ्जः) A charming murmur.

सञ्जुघोष mfn. (-घः-घा-घं) Having a sweet voice or cry. m. (-घः) One of the Baud'dha teachers. f. (-घा) One of the Apsaras or courtezans of Swarga. E. सञ्ज् agreeable, and घोष sound, voice.

सञ्जुनाश्री f. (-श्री) 1. A name of DURGA'. 2. The wife of INDRA. 3. A handsome woman. E. सञ्ज् beautiful and नाश destruction; putting every other beauty to shame by their superiority.

सञ्जुपाठक m. (-कः) A parrot.

सञ्जुप्राण m. (-णः) A name of BRAHMA'. E. सञ्ज् pleasing and प्राण life.

सञ्जुभद्र m. (-द्रः) Baud'dha; also called Manjughosha.

सञ्जुभाषिन् mfn. (-षी-षी-षी) Speaking sweetly or pleasantly. f. (-षी) 1. A woman speaking kindly. 2. A species of Atijagati' metre. E. सञ्ज् and भाषिन् who speaks.

सञ्जुल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Beautiful, agreeable, pleasing. m. (-लः) A gallinule. n. (-लं) 1. A natural water-course or channel, a spring, a well. 2. An harbour, a bower. 3. An aquatic plant, (Vallisneria octandra.) E. सञ्ज् handsome, ला to be, aff. क । [face.]

सञ्जुवक्र mfn. (-क्रः-क्रा-क्रं) Lovely, handsome. E. सञ्ज् beautiful, वक्र the

सञ्जुश्री m. (-श्रीः) A Baud'dha saint; see सञ्जुघोष ।

सञ्जुषा f. (-षा) 1. A basket, a large basket. 2. A stone. 3. Bengal madder. 4. The case in which the great bow that RA'MA broke, was kept. E. सञ्ज् to make pure or clean by ablution, Unádi aff. ञषन्, and the nasal augment; also with a short vowel सञ्जुषा ।

सञ्जुती f. (-ती) Hail; also सञ्जुची ।

सञ्जुस्फटि m. (-टिः) Incipient pride. [corocana.]

सञ्जुक n. (-कः) 1. The ridge of a thatch. 2. A sort of grain, (Eleusine)

सञ्जु r. 1st cl. (सञ्जति) 1. To be confused or disturbed in mind. 2. To dwell, to inhabit. 3. To grind. 4. To go. (इ) सञ्जि r. 1st cl. (सञ्जते) 1. To bewail, to regret, to remember with sorrow or regret. 2. To long for.

सञ्ज m. (-जः) 1. A school, a college, the residence of young Bráhmans, prosecuting sacred studies. 2. A building inhabited by ascetics of the same order. 3. A temple. 4. A cart, a carriage, particularly drawn by oxen. E. सञ्ज् to dwell, aff. ञच् ।

सञ्जर m. (-रः) The name of a Muni or saint. f. (-रा) Intoxicated. E. सञ्ज् to respect, Unádi aff. ञरच्, and ङ substituted for the radical final.

सञ्जो f. (-ठी) A cell. 2. A cloister.

सञ्जु (इ) सञ्जि r. 1st cl. (सञ्जते) 1. To divide, to separate. 2. To clothe. 3. To surround, to encompass. r. 1st and 10th cls. (सञ्जति सञ्जयत-ते) To adorn, to grace, to decorate. r. 10th cl. (सञ्जयति-ते) To gladden, to rejoice, to make happy.

सञ्जक m. (-कः) A kind of grain, (Eleusine corocana.) E. सञ्जि-कुन् ।

सञ्जुडु m. (-डुः) A sort of drum. E. सञ्ज् to purify, aff. उन्, deriv. irr.; also with कन् added, सञ्जुडु क ।

सञ्ज r. 1st cl. (सञ्जति) To sound, to sound inarticulately.

सणि mf. (-णिः-णिः-णी) 1. A gem, a jewel, a precious stone. 2. Ornament in general. 3. A load-stone, a magnet. 4. Any thing excellent of its kind. 5. A pearl. 6. Fleishy processes pending from the neck of a goat. 7. A small water-pot. 8. The glans penis. 9. The clitoris. 10. The wrist. 11. One of the Na'gas or serpent chiefs of Pátála. E. सण् to sound, aff. इन् । [the same, aff. कन् ।

सणिक n. (-कः) A small water-jar, a pitcher. m. (-कः) A jewel. E. सण्

सणिकण्ड m. (-ण्डः) The blue jay. E. सण् a jewel, and कण्ड the throat.

सणिकण्डक m. (-कः) A cock.

सणिकर्ण mfn. (-र्णः-र्णा-र्णी-र्णं) Jewel-eared. E. सण्, and कर्ण the ear.

सणिकर्णिका f. (-का) A holy pool at Benares, in which pilgrims are directed to bathe. E. सण्, and कर्ण the ear, aff. कन्, fem. form; Devi having dropped one of her ear-rings at this place.

सणिकाच m. (-चः) The feathered part of an arrow.

सणिकानन n. (-नं) The neck or throat. E. सण् a jewel, and कानन a wood; abounding with such ornaments.

सणिकार m. (-रः) A jeweller, a lapidary or worker in precious stones. E. सण् a gem, and कार who makes.

सणिकोव m. (-वः) One of KURVA's sons. E. सण् a gem, यौवा the neck.

सणिकिद्रा f. (-द्रा) 1. Marrow. 2. A sort of drug.

सणित n. (-तं) Low murmuring sound uttered at cohabitation. E. सण् to sound, aff. क्त । [aff. खुल् ।

सणितारक m. (-कः) The Indian crane. E. सण् a jewel, ऋ to pass over,

सणिकोप m. (-पः) 1. The crest or hood of the great serpent ANANTA. 2. Name of an island in the ocean of nectar. E. सण् a jewel, and कोप a continent.

सणिकनुव m. (-नुः) The rainbow. E. सण् a jewel, and चनुस् a bow.

सणिकुण्डक m. (-कः) The conch-shell of Sahade'va.

सणिकूर् m. (-रः) 1. The navel. 2. A sort of bodice worn by women, and often richly ornamented with. n. (-रं) 1. The pit of the stomach, as one of the mystical Chakras of the body; see चक्र. 2. Name of a town in Kalinga. E. सण् a jewel, and पूर filling, full.

सणिकवन्ध m. (-न्धः) The wrist. E. सण् a jewel, and वन्ध binding; where bracelets of precious stones are bound.
