

सन्दुरज mfn. (-जः-जा-ज) Born in a stable. E सन्दुरा, and ज born, the final of the first rejected.

सन्दुरा f. (-रा) 1. A stable. 2. A bed, a mat used as one. E. सदि to please, &c. Unádi aff. उरच् ।

सन्दोष्क m. (-ष्कः) The apsis of a planet's orbit. E. सन्द and उष्क high.

सन्दोदरी f. (-री) A proper name, the wife of RA'VAN'A. E. सन्द slow, heavy, उदर the belly, aff. डीच् ।

सन्दोदरीश m. (-शः) A name of RA'VAN'A. E. सन्दोदरी as above, and ईश lord or husband. [king, and सुत son.

सन्दोदरीसुत m. (-तः) The son of RA'VAN'A. E. सन्दोदरी the wife of the सन्दोदरी mfn. (-शः-शा-श) Temperate, tepid, moderately warm. n. (-श) Warmth, gentle heat. E. सन्द slack, and उष्ण hot.

सन्द m. (-न्दः) 1. A base or low tone, such as the grumbling of clouds, &c. 2. A sort of drum. 3. A species of elephant. f. (-द्वा) Hollow, deep, rumbling. E. सदि to please, Unádi aff. रक् ।

सन्धय m. (-यः) 1. A name of KA'MA, the god of love. 2. Love, amorous passion or desire. 3. The elephant or wood-apple. E. सत् the heart, सय् to agitate, aff. अच् ।

सन्ध्यालय m. (-यः) 1. Pudendum muliebre. 2. The mango tree. [aff. सन्धयिन् mfn. (-यि-यिनी-यि) Amorous, impassioned, in love. E. सन्धय, इनि सन्धन m. (-नः) Whispering, murmuring, low reiterated sound, especially murmur libidinosum. E. सत् the heart or mind, सन् to express, aff. अच् ।

सन्धय mfn. (-यः-या-य) Full of me, like me, (God.) E. सत् and सयट् aff.

सन्धसान mfn. (-नः-ना-न) 1. Thinking, considering. 2. Respecting, attending to. 3. Praising. E. सन् to mind, शानच् aff.

सन्धा f. (-न्धा) The tendon forming the nape of the neck. E. सन् to mind, to admire, aff. क्यप् ।

सन्धाका f. (-का) The tendon of the trapezium muscle forming the nape of the neck. E. सन्धा the same, and कन् added.

सन्धु m. (-न्धुः) 1. Sorrow, grief. 2. Distress, indigence. 3. Anger, wrath. 4. A sacrifice. 5. Pride. E. सन् to know, Unádi aff. युच् ।

सन्धुसत् mfn. (-सन्-सती-सत्) 1. Sorrowful, distressed. 2. Angry, wrathful. E. सन्धु, and सतुप् aff.

सन्वत्तर n. (-त्तर) The reign of a MANU, a period equal to seventy-one ages of the gods, or 306, 720,000 years of mortals, or with its Sandhi or interval of universal deluge, 308, 448, 000 years; fourteen Manwantaras constitute a Kalpa; the grand period of creation and destruction, or 4, 320, 000, 000 years; each Manwantara is governed by its distinct MANU, and is provided with its own INDRA, and minor deities; according to Hindu cosmogony, there have been innumerable Manwantaras, since the first creation of the world. E. सन् MANU, and अन्तर period or interval.

सन्धान mfn. (-नः-ना-न) 1. Thinking, conceiving. 2. Minding, regarding. E. सा to mind, शानच् aff. [सपष्टक ।

सपष्ट m. (-ष्टः) A sort of bean, (Phaseolus mungo;) also सपष्टक, and सपष्टक m. (-कः) A sort of bean, (Phaseolus mungo.) also सयष्टक ।

सय् r. 1st cl. (सयति) To go, to move.

सय Ind. The genitive singular of the first personal pronoun.

सयता f. (-ता) 1. Pride, arrogance, self-sufficiency. 2. The interest or affection entertained for other objects from considering them as belonging to or connected with one's self. 3. Individuality. E. सय mine, the possessive case of अस्मद्, and तल् aff. of the abstract; also with ल aff. समत् ।

सयतायुक्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्या-क्त) Selfish. m. (-क्तः) A miser, a niggard. E. सयता selfishness, and युक्त affected.

सयपताल m. (-लः) An object of sense. E. सय to bind, चालन् Unádi aff., य rejected, and स substituted for व, and आपतुद् augment.

सय r. 1st cl. (सयते) To go, to move.

सय m. (-यः) 1. A camel. 2. A mule. 3. A demon, and the carpenter

or architect of the DAITYAS. 4 Hurting, injuring. 5 (-यः) Administering remedies, the practice of physic. f. (-यो) Used as an affix in the sense of "consisting of" "Made of" Full of. E. सय् to go, or सि to scatter, or सो to hurt, affs. अच् or खल् and टाप् ।

सयट् m. (-टः) A hut of grass or leaves. E. सय to go, अटच् aff.

सयु m. (-युः) 1. A KINNARA or chorister of Swarga, 2. A deer. E. सि to scatter, (sweet sounds, &c.) Unádi aff. उ ।

सयुराज m. (-जः) A name of KUV'RA. E. सयु KINNARA, and राज chief; having these beings attached especially to his court and capital.

सयुष्टक m. (-कः) A sort of bean, (Phaseolus mungo.) E. सय् to go, aff. उ, सयु one who goes, षक् to impede, aff. ड, सयुष्ट, and with the pleonastic addition, कन् सयुष्टक; also with अच् aff. after सय् to go, सयष्ट, and सयष्टक; and again with प substituted for स, सपष्ट, सपष्टक. सपष्ट or सपष्टक ।

सयुख m. (-खः) 1. Light, lustre, brightness. 2. A ray of light. 3. Flame. 4. Beauty. 5. The pin or gnomon of a sun-dial. E. सा to measure, (time, &c.) ऊख Unádi aff., सय substituted for the root.

सयूर m. (-रः) 1. A peacock. 2. A flower, the coxcomb, (Celosia cristata.) 3. A plant, (Achyranthes aspera.) f. (-री) 1. A pea-hen. 2. A potherb, (Basella rubra, &c.) E. सि to scatter, Unádi aff. ऊरन्; or सद्यौ the earth in the seventh case, सज्या, ह् to cry, ड aff. and the formation irr.

सयूरक m. (-कः) 1. A plant, (Achyranthes aspera.) 2. A flower, (Celosia cristata.) 3. A peacock. n. (-क) Blue vitriol. E. कन् added to the preceding.

सयूरशीवक n. (-क) Blue vitriol "तुँते" ।

सयूरचटक m. (-कः) A house or dunghill cock. [the comb or crist.

सयूरचूडा f. (-डा) Coxcomb, (Celosia cristata.) E. सयूर a peacock. चूडा सयूरपदक n. (-क) A sort of scratch with a finger-nail. E. सयूर a peacock, पद a foot, and कन् aff.; implying resemblance. [the enemy.

सयूरारि m. (-रिः) A chameleon, a lizard. E. सयूर a peacock, and अरि सरक m. (-कः) Epidemic or pestilential disease. E. ह् to die, वुन् aff.

सरकत m. (-तः) An emerald. E. सरक epidemic disease, तृ to cross or escape, aff. ड; it is also read सरकतक n. (-क) ।

सरक्त n. (-क्त) An emerald.

सरण n. (-ण) Death, dying. E. ह् to die, aff. लुट् ।

सरत m. (-तः) Death, dying. E. ह् to die, अतच् Unádi aff.

सरन्द m. (-न्दः) The nectar or honey of a flower. E. सकारन्द, q. v. the second syllable being rejected; also with कन् added सरन्दक ।

सरन्दौकस् n. (-कः) A flower. E. सरन्द nectar or honey, औकस् abode.

सराकाली f. (-ली) a plant, commonly Bich'huti'.

सरार m. (-रः) A granary, a place where grain, &c. is kept.

सराल mfn. (-लः-ला-लौ-ल) Soft, mild, bland. m. (-लः) 1. A sort of goose with red legs and bill, or perhaps the Flamingo. 2. Lamp-black, used as a collyrium. 3. A duck. 4. A horse. 5. A cloud. 6. A grove or garden of pomegranate trees. 7. A rogue, a scoundrel. f. (-ला) Greasy, soft. E. ह् to die, aff. चालच् ।

सरिच n. (-च) Pepper. E. ह् to die, (venom,) and इच् aff.; considered as an antidote; also सरीच ।

सरिसन् m. (-सन्) Death, dying. E. ह् to die, सनिन् Unádi aff.

सरीच n. (-च) Pepper, (Piper nigrum.) E. ह् to die, इच् aff.

सरीचि m. (-चिः) 1. A saint, the son of BRAHMA', and one of the Praja'patis, and Brahma'dikas, or first created beings, and sovereigns of the world. 2. A niggard, a miser. mf. (-चिः) A ray of light. E. ह् to perish, (darkness,) Unádi aff. ईचि ।

सरीचिका f. (-का) The Mirage; vapour which in hot and sandy countries especially appears at a distance like a sheet of water. E. सरीचि a ray of light, कन् aff., implying resemblance.

सरीचिसालिन् mfn. (-ली-लिनी-लि) Splendid, radiant. m. (-ली) The sun. E. सरीचि and सालिन् having a chaplet.
