मासुख्य m. (-यः) MA'RKANDE'YA a holy sage, the supposed author or narrator of one of the Purānas, named the Ma'rkande'ya Pura'n'a. **म** सुख the father of the sage, and टक् aff.
मासुव m. (-वः) A spreading shrub ; see सुवराज ।

मार्गव m. (-वः) A man of a low caste, born of a Nishada by an Ayoga-
मार्गशिर m. (-रः) The month Agrahāyan'a, (November-December.) **म** शिर the asterism in which the moon is full, and अण् aff. ; also from सुवशीर्ष with अण् aff. मार्गशीर्ष ।

मार्गशीर्ष m. (-र्षः) The month Mārgas'irsha : see the last.
मार्गिक m. (-कः) 1. A deer-killer, a hunter. 2. A traveller, a way-farer. **म** र्ग a deer, or मार्ग a road, टक् aff. [for, aff. क् ।
मार्गित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Sought, inquired after, pursued. **म** मार्ग to seek

मार्जार mf. (-रः-रो) 1. The common cat. 2. The wild or pole-cat. f. (-री) 1. A female cat. 2. Musk. **म** र्गज् to cleanse, (its skin and face) चारन् aff., and the vowel made long ; also read मार्जाल ।
मार्जारक m. (-कः) 1. A cat. 2. A peacock. **म** मार्जार a cat, and कन् aff. to the last.
मार्जारकण्ड m. (-ख्डः) A peacock, perhaps a wrong reading for the last.
मार्जारकरण n. (-णं) A particular mode of sexual enjoyment.
मार्जारकर्षिका f. (-का) A goddess, a form of DURGA'. **म** मार्जार a cat, कर्ष the ear, कन् aff. fem. form ; also मार्जारकर्षी having the ears of a cat.
मार्जारगन्धिका f. (-का) A sort of pulse, (Phaseolus trilobus.) "सुवपखं" **म** मार्जार a cat, गन्ध smell, कन् aff. of comparison ; also मार्जारगन्धा ।
मार्जारी(ली)य mf. (-यः-या) 1. A cat. 2. A S'u'dra : see मार्जालीय ।
मार्जाल m. (-लः) A cat. **म** See मार्जार, the final being changed to ल ।
