

भास्र m. (-रः) The scum of boiled-rice. E. मस् to measure, aff. अरन्, and the vowel made long.

भासवर्ति का f. (-का) A kind of bird. E. भास a month, इत् to be, aff. वृन् ।

भासान्त m. (-न्तः) Day of new-moon. E. भास the month, and अन्त end.

भासिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) 1. Monthly, relating or belonging to a month. 2. Payable in a month, (a debt, &c.) 3. Hired by the month, (a servant.) 4. Lasting for a month. 5. Happening or occurring at the end of a month, what will occur a month hence, &c. n. (-के) A particular Shra'd'd'ha, or obsequial sacrifice performed every day of new-moon, during the first year of the death of a man. E. भास a month, and टक् or टज् aff.

भासोन mfn. (-नः-ना-ने) Of a month, a month old. E. भास, and खज् aff.

भासु(सूरी) f. (-री) The beard. E. मस् to measure, aff. उरन्, form irr.

भास्य Ind. A prohibitive particle. E. भा prohibitive, and अ termination added ; or मस्-षिच्-वा० म् । [यत् aff.]

भास्य mfn. (-स्य-स्या-स्य) Of or lasting a month, a month old. E. भास, भाह् (उ, or ष) भाहु or भाह् r. 1st cl. (माहति-ते) To mete, to measure.

भाहन m. (-नः) A Bra'hmana. E. भा prohibitive prefix, हन् to kill, aff. षच्, radical letters unchanged. [टाप् ।]

भाहा f. (-हा) A cow. E. भा prohibitive prefix, हन् to kill, affs. उ and माहाकुल mfn. (-लः-ली-लं) Of a respectable family. E. महाकुल of respectable lineage, and अच् aff. of descent ; also with खज् aff., माहाकुलीन, or with ख महाकुलीन ।

भाहाजनिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Fit for or suitable to great persons, &c. E. महाजन, and टज् aff.

भाहात्मिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) 1. Glorious, majestic. 2. Magnanimous. 3. Of great sanctity or honour. E. महात्मन्, and टक् aff.

भाहात्म्य n. (-त्वं) 1. Majesty, greatness, might. 2. The peculiar efficacy or virtue of any divinity or sacred shrine, &c. 3. A work, giving an account of the merits of any holy place or object. E. महात्मन् great, अच् aff.

भाहानात्मिक m. (-कः) A Bra'hmana versed in a peculiar portion of the Ve'das. E. महानात्मी a portion of the Ve'das so called, and टज् aff. ; also with the final dropped, माहानात्मिक । [महाराज, टज् aff.]

भाहाराजिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Imperial, royal, fit for a king, &c. E. भाहिन n. (-ने) Kingdom, dominion. E. महिन the same, अच् pleonasm.

मगहिर m. (-रः) A same of INDRA.

माहिष mfn. (-षः-षी-ष) Belonging to or derived from a buffalo, (flesh, milk, &c.) E. महिष, and अच् aff.

माहिषक m. (-कः) A buffalo-keeper.

माहिषिक m. (-कः) 1. A buffalo-keeper. 2. The paramour of an unchaste woman. 3. One who lives by the prostitution of his wife.

माहिष्य m. (-ष्यः) A man of a mixed class, sprung from a Kshetriya father and Vais'ya mother. E. महिष a buffalo, and यत् aff., with अच् added ; attendance on cattle forming with the practice of astronomy and music, are the business of the Ma'hishya.

माहेन्द्र mfn. (-न्द्रः-न्द्रा-न्द्र) Relating to or belonging to INDRA, fit or proper for, (as an oblation to him, &c.) f. (-न्द्री) 1. The wife of INDRA. 2. A cow. 3. The east. E. महेन्द्र the deity, and अच् aff. ; also with क, माहेन्द्रिय, &c.

माहेय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Earthen, made of or from earth. m. (-यः) 1. Coral. 2. The planet Mars. f. (-यी) A cow. E. मही the earth, टक् aff.

माहेयरी f. (-री) 1. A name of DURGA'. 2. One of the divine mothers or energies of the gods, the Sakti' of S'IVA. E. महेयरी S'IVA, अच् and डीष् affs.

मि (डुज्) डुमिज् r. 5th cl. (मिनोति मिनुते) 1. To cast, to throw, to throw about, to scatter. 2. To measure. 3. To perceive. (This root is not used in classics.) [obstruct, to hinder.]

मिच्छ् r. 6th cl. (मिच्छति) 1. To pain, to inflict pain or distress. 2. To

मित mfn. (-तः-ता-ते) 1. Measured. 2. Moderate, limited, few or little. 3. Known, understood. 4. Examined. 5. Scattered, sprinkled. E. मा to mete, or मि to scatter, aff. क्त, form irr.

मितङ्गन mfn. (-नः-मा-नं) Going deliberately or slowly. m. (-नः) An elephant. f. (-मा) A she-elephant. E. मित measured, गन् to go, aff. खच् । [go, Unádi aff. क्त ।]

मितद्रु m. (-द्रुः) The ocean. E. मित what is measured, (the earth,) द्रु to

मितभुज् mfn. (-भुक्) Moderate, temperate. E. मित, भुज् who eats. &c.

मितम्यच mfn. (-चः-चा-चं) 1. Miserly, niggardly, a niggard, a miser. 2. Cooking little. E. मित measured, (food,) and पच who cooks, from पच् with खच् aff. [and वाच् speech.]

मितवाच् mfn. (-वाक्) Prudent in speaking, of measured speech. E. मित,

मितार्थ mfn. ((थः-थी-थे) Of certain or restricted meaning. m. (-र्थः) A cautious emissary. E. मित, and अर्थ sense.

मितारण mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Abstemious, moderate in diet, eating little and sparingly. E. मित measured, and अरण who eats.

मितार्थ Adj. 1. Short, brief. 2. Metrical.

मिति f. (-तिः) 1. Measuring, measure. 2. Weighing, weight. 3. Value. 4. Knowledge. 5. Proof, evidence. E. मा to measure, aff. क्तिन् ।

मित्र n. (-त्रं) 1. A friend. 2. An ally ; in this form it is always neuter ; but it is convertible into an attributive, and is then of three genders, (मित्रः-मित्रा-मित्रं) Friendly, a friend. m. (-त्रः) 1. The sun. 2. The name of a Ve'dic deity. f. (-त्रा) One of the wives of DASARATHA, the mother of SATRUGHN'A. E. मिद to be affectionate, aff. क्त ; hence more properly मित्र ।

मित्रकार्य n. (-र्यं) A friendly deed, friendship. E. मित्र and कार्य act.

मित्रत्व n. (-त्वं) Friendship, friendliness. E. मित्र with त्व aff. ; also with तल्, मित्रता । [injures.]

मित्रद्रुह् m. (-द्रुक्) A false or treacherous friend. E. मित्र, and द्रुह् who

मित्रद्विष् m. (-द्विष्ट) A treacherous friend. E. मित्र and द्विष् who hates.

मित्रभेद m. (-दः) Breach of friendship. E. मित्र and भेद division.

मित्रयु mfn. (-युः-यु-यु) Attractive, winning or acquiring friends. m. (-युः) 1. A rememberer or retainer of traditions, a person acquainted with popular and unrecorded customs. 2. A friend. E. मित्र a friend, या to obtain, aff. क्त.

मित्रयुद्ध n. (-द्धं) The contest of friends, the conflict of allies. E. मित्र, and युद्ध war. [acquisition.]

मित्रलब्धि f. (-ब्धिः) Acquirement of friendship. E. मित्र a friend, and लब्धि

मित्रलाभ m. (-भः) Acquirement of a friend or friendship, forming friendship, &c. E. मित्र a friend, and लाभ gain, acquisition.

मित्रवत्सल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Acquiring friendship, winning, captivating, engaging, etc. E. मित्र a friend, and वत्सल kind, affectionate.

मित्रशील् m. (-शीः) A ruler over his friends or allies. E. मित्र, and शास् to govern, क्तिप् aff., and ई substituted for the penultimate.

मित्रौयत् mfn. (-यन्-यन्-यन्) Becoming or acting as a friend, desiring friendship. E. मित्र nominal verb, श्ठ aff.

मित्रोदय m. (-यः) 1. Sunrise. 2. The prosperity of a friend.

मिथ् (च) मिथु r. 1st cl. (मिथति-ते) 1. To understand. 2. To injure, to hurt. 3. To unite, to pair. 4. To wrangle.

मिथस् Ind. 1. Mutually, reciprocally. 2. Privately. E. मिथ् to pair, aff. असुन् and the vowel unchanged.

मिथिला f. (-ला) A city, giving name also to a kingdom, lying north-east of Bengal, the modern Tirhut. E. मिथ् to be agitated, (enemies by that kingdom,) and ईलच् Unádi aff.

मिथुन n. (-नं) 1. A couple, a pair, a brace, male and female. 2. Copulation. 3. Union, junction. 4. Twins. 5. A root compounded with a preposition, (in gram.) m. (-नः) The sign Gemini of the zodiac. E. मिथ् to unite, उनन् Una'di aff.

मिथुनीभाव m. (-वः) Amorous inclination. E. मिथुन, भाव property, च्च् aff.

मिथुनेचर m. (-रः) The ruddy goose.
