

सुठि (इ) सुठि r. 1st cl. (सुखते) 1. To guard, to protect, to defend or cherish. 2. To fly, to run away.

सुड r. 6th cl. (सुडति) 1. To quit, to leave. 2. To clothe or cover. (इ.) सुडि r. 1st cl. (सुखते) 1. To be pure or clean. 2. To cleanse. 3. To sink, (as in water.) 4. To sink, (in estimation,) to be despised or disregarded. (सुखति) 1. To shave or cut. 2. To grind or pound.

सुष् r. 6th cl. (सुषति) To vow or promise.

सुख्ड mfn. (-ख्डः-खडा-ख्ड) 1. Shaved, bald, having no hair on the head. 2. Low, mean. mn. (-ख्डः-ख्ड) 1. The head. 2. The forehead. m. (-ख्डः) 1. A bald pate. 2. A barber. 3. The name of a Daitya or Demon. 4. RA'HU, the personified ascending node. 5. The trunk of a lopped tree. f. (-खडा) Bengal madder, (Rubia manjith.) E. सुडि to shave or cut, aff. चञ् ।

सुखडक m. (-कः) 1. A barber. 2. The trunk of a tree stripped of its branches. n. (-कः) The head. E. सुडि to shave, aff. चुन् ; or सुख्ड the head, कन् pleonasm ; or सुडि-पिचु खुल् ।

सुखडचणक m. (-कः) A kind of pulse. "कलाये ।" [खुट् ।

सुखडन n. (नः) Shaving, shearing, cutting. E. सुडि to shave or cut, aff. सुखडफल m. (-लः) The cocconut-tree. E. सुख्ड the head, and फल fruit ; the fruit being one step towards a human head, made by VISWA MITRA, when he purposed establishing an opposition creation to that of BRAHMA'.

सुखडमण्डली f. (-ली) 1. A number of shaven heads. 2. A mass of troops of an inferior description. E. सुख्ड and मण्डली a circle.

सुखडशालि m. (-लिः) A kind of grain or rice.

सुखडित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Bald, shaven. n. (-तः) Iron. E. सुख्ड bald, इतच् aff. सुखडितशिरस् mfn. (-राः-राः-रः) Bald-pated, shaven-headed. E. सुखडित, शिरस् the head.

सुखडितिका f. (-का) A plant, commonly Mun'di'ri'.

सुखडिन् m. (-खडि) 1. A barber. 2. S'IVA. E. सुख्ड shaving, aff. इनि ।

सुखडीरिका f. (-का) A plant, commonly Mun'di'ri'.

सुखडीरी f. (-री) A plant, described as a creeper, bearing a red and yellow flower, commonly called by the same name, Mun'di'ri'.

सुख n. (-खं) A pearl.

सुय् (इ) सुयि r. 1st cl. (सुयति) 1. To hurt or kill. 2. To suffer pain.

सुद् r. 1st cl. (सुदति) To rejoice, to be glad. r. 10th cl. (सुदयति-ते) 1. To mix, to blend, to unite. 2. To clean, to wipe off. With चतु To allow, to permit, to approve. With आ 1. To be glad. 2. To be fragrant.

सुद f. (-मुद्-मुत्) 1. Pleasure, delight, joy. 2. Intoxication, phrensy. 3. A wife. E. सुद् to be pleased, aff. क्विप् ।

सुदा f. (-दा) Happiness, joy. E. सुद् to be happy, अड् and टाप् affs.

सुदानित mfn. (तः-ता-तं) Pleased, happy. E. सुदा and अनित possessed of.

सुदित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Pleased, delighted. n. (-तं) Pleasure, happiness. E. सुद् to rejoice, aff. क्त ।

सुदिर m. (-रः) 1. A cloud. 2. A lover, a libertine. 3. A frog. E. सुद् to be pleased, Unádi aff. किरच् ।

सुदी f. (-दी) Moonlight. E. सुद् to please, affs. क and डीष् ।

सुङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) 1. A sort of kidney-bean, (Phaseolus mungo.) 2. A cover, as a lid or cloth. 3. A kind of sea-bird. E. सुदि to please, Unádi aff. गक् नेट् । "सुग् ।"

सुङ्गपर्णी f. (-णी) A sort of kidney-bean, (Phaseolus trilobus.) E. सुङ्ग P. mungo, पर्ण a leaf, डीष् aff. "सुगानी ।"

सुङ्गमुज् m. (-मुक्) A horse. E. सुङ्ग kidney-bean, सुज् who eats : also सुङ्गभोजिन् m. (-जी) ।

सुङ्गर m. (-रः) 1. A mallet, a mace, a weapon formed like a carpenter's hammer. 2. A staff, armed with iron, and larger at the lower extremity, used for breaking clods of earth, &c. 3. A carpenter's hammer. 4. A sort of flower, said to be a kind of jasmine, perhaps jasminum zambac, (the wild variety.) E. सुद् pleasure, गतो swal-

low or destroy, aff. चञ् ; also with र changed to ल, सुङ्गल "कर्मात् इति च ; कासुराङ्गा इति भाषा ।"

सुङ्गट्ट m. (-ट्टः) A sort of kidney-bean, (Phaseolus lobatus.) E. सुङ्ग P. mungo, स्था to stay, to resemble, aff. क ; also with कन् added सुङ्गट्टक ।

सुङ्गण n. (-णं) 1. Sealing. 2. Closing.

सुङ्गा f. (-ङ्गा) 1. A seal, a signet. 2. A seal-ring. 3. The mark of a seal or similar impression, a stamp, a print, &c. 4. A coin. 5. A medal. 6. A sign, a token. 7. A mystery. 8. A mode of intertwining the fingers during religious worship. E. सुद् to please, (by it,) Unádi aff. रक् ।

सुङ्गाङ्कित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Stamped, sealed. f. (-ता) A mint. E. सुङ्गा a seal, अङ्कित marked. [fem. form सुङ्गाङ्किता]

सुङ्गाङ्किका f. (-का) A sealed or signed paper. E. सुङ्गा a seal, कन् aff. सुङ्गाङ्कित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Sealed. 2. Marked, struck, stamped. 3. Contracted, closed, sealed up. 4. Unblown, (as a flower.) E. सुङ्गा a seal, इतच् aff. [aff. का ; इ changed to घा]

सुषा Ind. In vain, uselessly, unprofitably, idly. E. सुच् to be foolish.

सुनि m. (-निः) 1. A holy sage, a pious and learned person, endowed with more or less of a divine nature, or having attained it by rigid abstraction and mortification ; the title is applied to the Rishis, the Brahmadikás, and to a great number of persons distinguished for their writings, considered as inspired, as PA'NINI, Vya'SA, &c. 2. An ascetic, a devotee. 3. An Arhat or Jaina deified teacher. 4. The saint AGASTYA. 5. The Palás'h tree, (Butea frondosa.) 6. Another tree, (Buchanania latifolia.) E. सन् to be revered, Unádi aff. इन्, and उ substituted for the radical vowel.

सुनिच्छद m. (-दः) सन्च्छदे. "छातिम् ।"

सुनिद्रुम m. (-मः) A tree, (Æschynomene grandiflora.) E. सुनि the saint AGASTYA, and द्रुम a tree. "श्रीनाक इति, वकवृक्षे च ।"

सुनिपित्तल n. (-लं) Copper. E. सुनि a devotee, and पित्तल brass.

सुनिपुङ्गव m. (-वः) A pre-eminent sage. E. सुनि a sage, and पुङ्गव, (in composition) pre-eminent.

सुनिपुङ्गवक m. (-कः) A wagtail. E. सुनि a sage, पुङ्गव a child, and कन् aff. of comparison. "दमन इति ।" [सुनि and पून Areca.]

सुनिपूग m. (-गः) A kind of Areca, (A. triandra, or gracilis, Rox.) E. सुनिभेषज n. (-जं) 1. Fasting. 2. The fruit of the yellow myrobalan. 3. The saint AGASTYA. E. सुनि a sage, भेषज a drug or medicament.

सुनिसुव्रत m. (-तः) The twentieth Jaina pontiff of the present era.

सुनिस्थान n. (-नं) A hermitage, the abode or retirement of holy sages. E. सुनि an ascetic, and स्थान a place.

सुनीन्द्र m. (-न्द्रः) 1. A superior Muni or sage. 2. A Budd'ha, a Baud'd'ha sage or teacher. E. सुनि a sage, and इन्द्र chief.

सुय् r. 1st cl. (सुयति) To go, to move.

सुयन्न n. (-न्नः) Wild grain, roots, fruit, &c. E. सुनि a hermit, अन्न food.

सुमुचा f. (-चा) 1. Desire of liberation. 2. Desire of final emancipation.

सुमुचु m. (-चुः) 1. A sage, abstracted from all human passion and feeling, and preparing himself for eternal emancipation. 2. Any one anxious for liberation, especially from mundane existence. E. सुच् to liberate, in the desiderative form, उ aff.

सुमुचान m. (-नः) A cloud. [aff. सुमुचिषु mfn. (-षुः-षुः-षु) Wishing to steal. E. सुष् to steal, desid. v., उ सुमुचिषु वत् Ind. Like a thief. E. सुम्, विषुवति aff. [and टाप् affs.]

सुमुषा f. (-षा) Wish to die, impatience of life. E. सु to die, desid v., अड् सुमुषु m. (-षुः) A man at the point of the death, a dying-man. E. सु to die, desiderative or expectative form, and उ aff.

सुर् r. 6th cl. (सुर्ति) To encircle, to entwine, to bind together.

सुर् f. (-ः) Fainting. E. सुच् to faint, aff. क्विप्, the ह reject after र ।

सुर m. (-रः) The name of a DAITYA killed by VISHN'U. f. (-रा)
