सुरज m. (-जः) 1. A small drum, a tabor. 2. A stanza the letters of which can be arranged in the form of a drum. f. (-जा) 1. The wife of KUVĒRA. 2. A large drum. E. सुर encircling, with wood, &c. ज born, made.

सुरजफल m. (-लः) The jack-fruit tree, (*Artocarpus integrifolia*.)

सुरख m. (-खः) A country on the north west of Hindusthan, called also Lampaka, and now Lamgan. m. Plu (-खः) The inhabitants of Lamgan. [alarm,] aff. ड ।

सुरद m. (-दः) The conch of VISHN'U. E. सुर a demon, दी to cut, (to-सुरदला f. (-ला) The Narmadā river.

सुरमख m. (-खः) Pimples on the face.

सुररिपु m. (-पुः) A name of KRISHN'A or VISHN'U. E. सुर the demon, रिपु enemy.

सुरला f. (-ला) The Narmadā river. [affs. क and डीष् ।

सुरलि f. (-ली) A flute, a pipe. E. सुर surrounding, ला to get or have, सुरलीधर m. (-र ) A name of KRISHN'A. E. सुरली a flute, धर who holds.

सुरहन् m. (-हः) A name of VISHN'U. E. सुर the demon, हन् slayer.

सुरारि m. (-रिः) A name of VISHN'U. E. सुर the demon, अरि the foe.

सुच्छ् (चा) सुच्छा r. 1st cl. (सुच्छति) 1. To be faint, to lose consciousness or perception. 2. To increase, to grow. 3. To settle in a solid form, to become dense. 4. To prevail against. 5. To be frequent. 6. To sound loudly. With सप्त To be intense.

सुभिषो f. (-षो) A small fire-place or fire-pan.

सुसुर m. (-रः) 1. A name of KA'MA or CUPID. 2. A fire of chaff. 3. One of the horses of the sun. E. सुर-क प्रवी० हिलम् ।

सुव (ई) सुवीं r. 1st cl. (सुवति) To bind, to tie.

सुल r. 10th cl. (सोलयति-ते) To plant; more usually मूल ।

सुशटो f. (-टो) A kind of panick-seed, (*Panicum italicum*,) described as a white variety. E. सुव-अटच् गौरा डीष् प्रवी० ।

सुश(स)ली f. (-ली) A small house-lizard; see सुषली; also with कन् added सुशलिका f. (-का) ।

सुष् r. 1st cl. (सोषति) To injure, to kill. r. 9th cl. (सुष्णाति) 1. To steal, to rub, to plunder. 2. To captivate. 3. To surpass. r. 4th cl. (सुष्पति) 1. To cut, to divide, to break, 2. To steal.

सुषक m. (-कः) A rat; see सूषक ।

सुषल m. (-लः) 1. A club, a mace. 2. A pestle for cleaning rice. f. (-ली) 1. A house-lizard. 2. A plant, (*Curculigo orchoides*;) see सुषली, सुसल, and सुसली ।

सुषलामुषलि Ind. Club to club, (fighting, &c.) E. सुषल repeated, इच् added; also सुसलामुसली ।

सुख्य mfn. (-ल्यः-ल्य-ल्य) Meriting or pounding to death; see सुसुख्य ।

सुषा f. (-षा) A crucible. E. सुष् to steal, affs. अङ् and टाप्; also सुषा ।

सुषित mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Stolen, robbed. E. सुष् to steal, aff. क्त ।

सुष्क m. (-कः) 1. The scrotum. 2. The testicle. 3. A heap, a quantity. 4. A thief. 5. A stout man. 6. A plant, commonly Ghan'tāpārālī. E. सुष् to steal, (semen, &c.) कक् aff.

सुष्कक m. (-कः) 1. A plant, commonly Ghan'tāpārālī. E. सुष्क a thief, (of disease,) कन् added.

सुष्कद्वय n. (-यं) The testicles. E. सुष्क and द्वय pair. [रच् aff.]

सुष्कर m. (-रः) A man with large testicles. E. सुष्क testicle, and सुष्कगुण m. (-गुणः) An eunuch, a guard of the women's apartments. E. सुष्क testicle, and गुण wanting.

सुष्ट n. (-ष्ट) Theft, robbery. E. सुष् to steal, aff. क्त, form irr.

मुष्टि mf. (-ष्टिः-ष्टी) 1. The fist, the closed hand, 2. The hilt or handle of a sword, etc. 3. A handful or Pala, the initiatory measure in the tables of the measures of grain. 4. The penis. 5. Filching, stealing. E. सुष् to steal or take, aff. क्तिच् ।

मुष्टिक m. (-कः) 1. A goldsmith. 2. A particular position of the hands,

3. Name of a demon killed by BALADE'VA. n. (-कः) A pugilistic encounter. E. मुष्टि stealing and क्त to make, aff. ड ।

मुष्टिकान्तक m. (-कः) A name of BALADE'VA the brother of KRISHN'A.

मुष्टिद्युत् n. (-त्) A kind of game, odd or even. E. मुष्टि the fist, द्युत् gaming. "पुग्मुट् ।"

मुष्टिन्धम mfn. (-मः-मा-म) Who blows in or on his closed fist. E. मुष्टि, and धा to breathe, aff. खच् ।

मुष्टिन्धय m. (-यः) A child. E. मुष्टि the fist, धे to drink or suck, aff. खग् ।

मुष्टिपात m. (-तः) Pummeling, boxing. E. मुष्टि, पात falling.

मुष्टिबन्ध m. (-न्धः) Clenching the fist. E. मुष्टि the fist, बन्ध binding.

मुष्टिसंघाहपीडित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Squeezed, pressed, griped. E. मुष्टि, संघाह taking, पीडित squeezed.

मुष्टिमुष्टि Ind. Fist to fist, (fighting,) fisticuffs. E. मुष्टि repeated in this sense, and the final made long.

मुष्त् mfn. (-ष्त्-ष्त्-ष्त्) 1. Stealing, robbing. 2. Depriving of. 3. Obscuring, eclipsing. E. मुष् to steal, श्त् aff.

मुस् (इर) मुस्तिर r. 4th cl. (मुस्ति) To divide, to cut or break to pieces.

मुसल n. (-लः) 1. A pestle, a wooden pestle used for cleaning rice. 2. A club. f. (-ली) 1. A plant, (*Curculigo orchoides*.) 2. A house-lizard. E. मुस् to break, aff. कलच्; it is also read with its compounds and derivatives मुवल, मुषली, and sometimes मुशल, &c.

मुसलिन m. (-ली) A name of BALARA'MA. E. मुसल a pestle, or pestle-like club, used by him as a weapon, इनि aff.

मुसल mfn. (-ल्यः-ल्य-ल्य) Deserving death by pounding with a pestle. E. मुसल a pestle, यत् aff.

मुस्त् r. 10th cl. (मुस्यति-ते) To accumulate, to collect, to heap together.

मुस्त mf. (-स्तः-स्ता) A sort of grass, (*Cyperus rotundus*.) E. मुस्त to accumulate, aff. अच् "मुधा ।"

मुस्तक mn. (-कः-कं) 1. A fragrant grass, (*Cyperus rotundus*.) 2. A sort of poison. E. मुस्त to accumulate, खल् aff.

मुस्ताद m. (-दः) A hog. E. मुस्ता *Cyperus*, and अद् who eats.

मुस्तु m. (-स्तुः) The fist. E. मुस् to break, तुन् aff.

मुस n. (-न्) 1. A pestle. 2. A tear. E. मुस् to divide, Una'di aff. रच् ।

मुह् (ज) मुह् r. 4th cl. (मुहति) To be foolish, to be incapable of discrimination or judgment, to be bereft of sense or wisdom.

मुहिर m. (-रः) 1. Love, desire, KA'MADE'VA. 2. A fool, a blockhead. E. मुह् to grow foolish, Una'di aff. किरच् ।

मुहुर्भाषा f. (-षा) Tautology, repetition. E. मुहुस् repeatedly, भाषा speech.

मुहुस् Ind. 1. Repeatedly, reiteratedly, again and again. 2. For a moment. E. मुह् to be foolish, Una'di aff. उरिक् ।

मुहुर्त् mn. (-त्तः-त्तं) A division of time, the thirtieth part of a day and night, or an hour of forty-eight minutes. m. (-त्तः) An astrologer. E. हुह् to be crooked or fraudulent, क्त aff., form irr., and मुक् initiatory augment. [एरक् Una'di aff.]

मुहिर m. (-रः) A fool, a blockhead, an ignoramus. E. मुह् to be foolish.

मूर् r. 1st cl. (मवते) To bind, to tie, to make fast.

मूर् f. (-मूर्) Binding, tying. E. मूर् to tie, aff. क्तिप् ।

मूर्क mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Dumb. 2. Poor, wretched. m. (-कः) 1. A fish. 2. A demon. 3. A pauper. E. मूर् imitative sound, and कै to utter, aff. क; or मूर् to bind, कक् aff.

मूर्कमन् m. (-मन्) Silence, dumbness.

मूढ mfn. (-ढः-ढा-ढं) 1. Foolish, ignorant. 2. Cold, apathetic, stupid. 3. Perplexed, in doubt. 4. Deceived, erring. m. (-ढः) 1. An idiot, a fool. 2. A sluggard. E. मूह् to be foolish, aff. क्त, form irr.

मूढगर्भ m. (-र्भः) 1. A bad presentation of the child at birth, causing difficult delivery. 2. A dead foetus. E. मूढ, and गर्भ the foetus.

मूढयाह m. (-हः) Infatuation. E. मूढ, and याह seizure.

मूढचेतस् mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) Insane, bewildered. E. मूढ, and चेतस् mind.

मूढता f. (-ता) Folly, silliness, ignorance. E. मूढ, and तल् aff.; also मूढत्व, मूढामन् mfn. (-मन्-मन्-मन्) Foolish, a fool. E. मूढ, and आमन् self,
