

सृगधूतक m. (-कः) A jackal. E. सृग a deer, and धूतक a cheat; preying upon them only in consequence of his luring them into his reach.

सृगनाभि m. (-भिः) Musk. E. सृग a deer, (the musk-deer,) and नाभि the navel; the musk being formed in a bag attached to the belly of the animal about the navel.

सृगनाभिज्ज nf. (-ज-जा) Musk. E. सृग a deer, नाभि the navel, ज्ज produced.

सृगनेत्र mfn. (-त्र-त्रा-त्रं) Possessing or relating to the constellation Mri'gasir'sha. f. (-नी) A woman with beautiful eyes, or eyes like a deer. E. सृग the asterism, नी to get, षच् aff., and अच् added; or सृग a deer, and नेत्र the eye.

सृगराते m. (-तिः) A lion. E. सृग an animal or a deer, and पति lord.

सृगपद n. (-दं) A deer's foot. E. सृग, and पद for पाद foot. [aff., fem. form.

सृगपालिका f. (-का) The musk-deer. E. सृग a deer, पाल् to nourish, तुन्

सृगपिप्पु m. (-पुः) The moon. E. सृग a deer, and पिप्पु a mark or spot.

सृगसंधाजीव m. (-वः) A hunter, a deer-killer. E. सृग a deer, संध killing, and आजीव who lives by. [confinement.

सृगबन्धनी f. (-नी) A net for confining deer. E. सृग a deer, and बन्धनी

सृगभोजनी f. (-नी) Bitter apple or Colocynth. E. सृग, and भोजन eating.

सृगसद m. (-दः) Musk. E. सृग a deer, and सद passion, or fluid that distills from the elephant's temples when in rut, and to which this secretion is considered analogous.

सृगसदवासा f. (-सा) A musk-bag.

सृगसन्द्र m. (-न्द्रः) Name of a particular class of elephants.

सृगसाहका f. (-का) A female antelope. E. सृग, साह mother, कन् added.

सृगसान् mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Seeking, pursuing, hunting. E. सृग् to seek, शानच् aff.

सृगमुख m. (-खः) The sign Capricornus of the zodiac. [irr.

सृगया f. (-या) Chase, hunting. E. सृग् to search or seek, यत् aff., deriv.

सृगयु m. (-युः) 1. BRAHMA'. 2. A jackal. 3. A hunter. E. सृग a deer, या to go, कु Unádi aff., form irr; or सृग्-यु।

सृगराज्ज m. (-राट्) 1. A lion. 2. The sign Leo of the zodiac. 3. A tiger. 4. The moon. E. सृग an animal, and राज्ज who rules over; also with a final vowel सृगराज m. (-जः)

सृगरिपु m. (-पुः) A lion. E. सृग an animal, and रिपु the enemy.

सृगरौमज्ज mfn. (-जः-जा-जं) Woollen, (cloth, &c.) E. सृष an animal, रौम hair, and ज्ज produced, made.

सृगलाञ्छन m. (-नः) The moon. E. सृग a deer, लाञ्छन symbol, sign.

सृगलेखा f. (-खा) The deer-like streak on the disc of the moon. [च।]

सृगवाहन m. (-नः) Air, wind. E. सृग a deer, and वाहन vehicle. "स्वातिनक्षत्रे सृगव्य n. (-व्यः) 1. Chase, hunting. 2. The butt or mark in archery. E. सृग a deer, व्यच् to destroy, aff. ड।

सृगव्याघ्र m. (-घः) 1. A hunter. 2. The dog's star. 3. S'IVA.

सृगशर m. (-रः) A fawn.

सृगशिरस् n. (-रः) The fifth lunar mansion, containing three stars, one of which is ORIONIS, and figured by an antelope's head, whence its name. E. सृग a deer, and शिरस् the head; also सृगशिरा f. (-रा) or सृगशिरस् m. (-राः)।

सृगशीर्ष m. (-र्षः) The constellation Mri'gasir'sha; see the last. E. सृग a deer, and शीर्ष the head; also f. (-र्षा)।

सृगाक्षी f. (-क्षी) 1. Bitter-apple, (Cucumis coloquintida.) 2. A woman with eyes like a deer's. E. सृग a deer, अक्षि the eye.

सृगाङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) 1. The moon. 2. Air, wind. 3. Camphor. E. सृग a deer, and अङ्ग a symbol, or अक्षि to go, aff. अच्।

सृगाजिन n. (-नः) A deer-skin. E. सृग, and अजिन a skin.

सृगाजीव m. (-वः) 1. A hyena. 2. A hunter. E. सृग a deer, and आजीव who lives by or preys upon.

सृगाण्डजा f. (-जा) Musk. E. सृग a deer, अण्ड testicle, and ज्ज produced.

सृगाद् m. (-द् or -त्) A tiger. E. सृग a deer, अद् to eat, aff. क्तिन्।

सृगादन m. (-नः) 1. A hyena. 2. A leopard. f. (-नी) Colocynth, (Cucumis coloquintida.) "इन्द्रवारुणी" E. सृग a deer, and अदन eating.

सृगान्तक m. (-कः) The Chita' or hunting leopard. E. सृग a deer, अन्तक destroyer. [enemy.

सृगराति m. (-तिः) 1. A dog. 2. A lion. E. सृग a deer, and अराति an

सृगरि m. (-रिः) 1. A lion. 2. A tiger. 3. A dog, a hound. E. सृग a deer, and अरि an enemy.

सृगाविष् m. (-विष्) A hunter, a deer-killer. E. सृग a deer, व्यच् to destroy, with अङ् prefix, and द्विप् aff., and the semi-vowel changed.

सृगास्य m. (-स्यः) The sign Capricornus of the zodiac.

सृगित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Sought, pursued. E. सृग् to chase, aff. क्त।

सृगेन्द्र m. (-न्द्रः) A lion. E. सृग an animal, इन्द्र lord, master.

सृगेन्द्रचटक m. (-कः) A hawk, a falcon. E. सृगेन्द्र a lion, चटक a sparrow.

सृगेन्द्रमुख n. (-खं) 1. The lion's mouth. 2. A species of the Atijagati metre. E. सृगेन्द्र, and मुख mouth.

सृगै(शै)र्वाक m. (-कः) 1. A white deer. 2. Colocynth.

सृग्य mfn. (-ग्यः-ग्या-ग्यं) To be sought or inquired for. E. सृग् to search, क्वप् aff. [pass. v., शानच् aff.

सृग्यसान् mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Being sought or inquired after. E. सृग् to search.

सृग्वय m. (-यः) A heap of earth.

सृग्व्यकटिका f. (-का) A small cart of clay.

सृज्ज् (ज्) सृजू r. 2nd cl. (साष्टि) r. 1st and 10th cls. (साजति साजयति) 1. To clean, to cleanse. 2. To be clean or pure. 3. To ornament. 4. To sound. 5. To sharpen. With अप or प्र prefixed, 1. To sweep, to sweep away. 2. To clean. With सन् 1. To clean. 2. To stroke. 3. To filter.

सृज्ज m. (-जः) A musical instrument, probably a sort of tabor or drum. f. (-जा) 1. Cleansing the body, by washing, anointing, &c. 2. Purification, ablution. 3. Complexion. E. सृज्ज् to cleanse, to sound aff. क, or अङ्, and टाप् aff.

सृज्जान्वय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Clean, cleansed. E. सृजा. and अन्वय order.

सृजित f. (-ता) Adj. Wiped away, removed.

सृज्य mfn. (-ज्यः-ज्या-ज्यं) To be cleaned or purified. E. सृज्ज् to cleanse, क्वप् aff.; also सार्ग्यं।

सृड् r. 6th cl. (सृडति) r. 9th cl. (सृड्याति) 1. To delight, to make happy. 2. To rejoice, to be happy or delighted. r. 9th cl. (According to some authorities,) To grind or pound.

सृड् m. (-डः) 1. A name of S'IVA. 2. The fire that completes an oblation. f. [डा or -डा(दा)नी] DURGA', the wife of S'IVA. E. सृड् to be pleased or delighted, aff. क, fem. aff. डीष्, with आनुक् augment.

सृड्ङ्गण m. (-णः) A child, a pupil. E. सृड् to be pleased, Unádi aff. कङ्गण।

सृडीक m. (-कः) A deer. E. सृड् to delight, Unádi aff. कीकन्.

सृष्ट् r. 6th cl. (सृष्टति) 1. To hurt, to injure. 2. To kill.

सृष्टाल m. (-लः-लं) The film or fibres attached to the stalk of a lotus. n. (-लं) The root of a fragrant grass, (Andropogon muricatum.) "वीरवसूली". f. (-ली) A small fibre in the stalk of the water-lily. E. सृष्ट् to hurt, Unádi aff. कालन्।

सृष्टालिका f. (-का) A lotus-stalk.

सृष्टालिन् m. (-लिनः) A lotus. f. (-लिनो) 1. An assemblage of lotus flowers. 2. A place abounding with lotuses. 3. A lotus plant. E. सृष्टालिका fibre, इनि aff. [सयट् aff.; also सृष्टय।

सृष्टय mfn. (-यः-यी-यं) Made of earth or clay, (as procelain, &c.) E. सृष्ट, सृत् mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Dead, expired, extinct, defunct. 2. Calcined, reduced, (metals.) n. (-तं) 1. Solicited alms. 2. Death. E. सृ to die, aff. क्त.

सृत्तक n. (-कः) 1. A dead body, a corpse. 2. Impurity contracted by the death of a near relation. E. सृत्त dead, कन् added. [rison.

सृत्तकल्प mfn. (-ल्पः-ल्पा-ल्पं) Insensible, fainted. E. सृत्त, कल्प aff. of compa-

सृत्तकालक m. (-कः) A jackal. E. सृत्त dead, and कालक fond of.

सृत्तरुह n. (-रुहः) A grave.

सृत्तण्ड m. (-ण्डः) The sun.
