

शततन्त्र f. (-न्त्रः) The thread or string made of the flax of the *Crotalaria juncea*. E. शत and तन्त्र string.

शततालव mfn. (-वः-वै-वः) Made of San' string. E. शततन्त्र and शत aff.

शतपथी f. (-ष्ठीः) A tree, (*Pentaptera tomentosa*.) E. शत San', and पथ a leaf; having similar leaves.

शतपुष्पिका f. (-का) *Crotalaria* of several species. E. शत the San', उप a flower, aff. जौष् and कन् added, fem. form, implying resemblance; also शतपुष्पी, &c.

शतसून n. (-न्तः) 1. The fibre or flax of the San' plant, or string made from it. 2. A net made of hemp or of San', or the thread of the *Crotalaria juncea*. 3. Cerdage, twine. E. शत hemp, &c., तन्त्र a thread.

शतालु m. (-लुः) A plant, (*Cassia fistula*.)

शतोर n. (-रः) 1. A rock or small island in the midst of the river So'na. 2. An insular spot inclosed by the branches of the SARAJ'U, where it falls into the Ganges above CHUPRA'U, at BHRIGURA'S'HRAMA or BAGERISSAN; called also, the bank of the DARDARI'.

शतु m. (-हतः) 1. A bull set at liberty. 2. An eunuch. n. (-हतः) A multitude of lotus flowers. E. शत् or षष्ठ् to give, aff. उ, hence also षष्ठ्, and differently derived, शत्, षष्ठ् the more usual form; or षष्ठि-षष्ठ्।

शतटा f. (-ता) 1. The state of a bull let loose or at liberty. 2. Emasculation. E. शत् a bull set at liberty, &c. तन् aff.

शतिल m. (-लः) The name of a Muni, and ancestor of a particular family of Brahmans. E. शत् an eunuch, and इलू उनादि aff.

शतु m. (-हतः) 1. An eunuch. 2. An eunuch or emasculated attendant, as employed in a Harem or seraglio. 3. An impotent man. 4. A bull set at liberty. 5. A mad man or a drunken man. E. शत् to bear or endure, Una'di aff. उ; also षष्ठ् and षष्ठ्, &c.; or षष्ठ्-ठ तस्य वेच्छम्।

शत n. (-तः) 1. A hundred. 2. Any large number. E. शतो-डतच्।

शतक mfn. (-कः-का-कः) A hundred. m. (-कः) A century, a cento, a collection of one hundred stanzas, &c. E. शत a hundred, सत् aff.

शतकीति' m. (-त्तिः) A Jina or Jaina pontiff of the last age. E. शत a hundred, and कीति fame.

शतकुम्भ n. (-भः) Gold. m. (-भः) The name of a mountain. f. (-भाः) A plant, (*Phyalis flexuosa*). E. शत a hundred, and कुम्भ a water-jar.

शतकोटि m. (-क्तिः) INDRA's thunderbolt. f. (-क्तिः) A hundred crores. E. शत a hundred, कीटि edge or a crore.

शतकरु m. (-तुः) INDRA. E. शत a hundred, करु sacrifice; a hundred As'hwa-mé'dhas or sacrifices of an unbroken horse, elevating the sacrificer to the place and title of INDRA.

शतखण्ड n. (-ण्डः) Gold.

शतगु mfn. (-गुः-गुः-गुः) Possessed of a hundred cows, with as many, &c. E. शत, गु for गो a cow.

शतगुण min. (-गुः-गुः-गुः) A hundred times, a hundred-fold. E. शत, गुण a time.

शतस्त्री f. (-स्त्रीः) 1. A weapon; it is generally supposed to be a sort of fire-arms, or the ancient Indian rocket, but it is also described as a stone set round with iron spikes. 2. A female scorpion. 3. A plant, (*Galedupa arborea*). 4. A disease of the throat, apparently enlargement of the tonsils. E. शत a hundred, हन् to kill, affs. षष्ठ् and जौष् and the radical letters changed.

शतस्त्रद m. (-दः) The wood-pecker. E. शत a hundred, स्त्रद a feather.

शतसू mfn. (-सूः-सौ-सू) Hundredth. E. शत a hundred, सूप् aff.

शतसारा f. (-रा) The constellation S'ATABHISHA', q. v. E. शत a hundred or many, and दारा a star.

शतहु f. (-हुः) The river SUTLEJ, which rises in the Himalaya mountains in the vicinity, it is supposed, of the RA'VAN'A-HRADA, and running to the S. W. unites in the PUNJA'B with the BEYAH or VIPA'S'A', when it forms the HYPHASIS of the Greeks, and falls into the INDUS below MOOLTA'N. E. शत a hundred, (fold, or in a hundred branches,) हु to flow, Unádi aff. हु; form irr.

शतद्वार mfn. (-द्वः-द्वारः) Hundred-gated, having a hundred or a number of doors or outlets. E. शत and द्वार a door.

शतधा f. (-धा) Bent grass, (*Panicum dactylon*,) Ind. 1. In a hundred ways, a hundred-fold. 2. In a hundred parts. E. शत a hundred, (blooms,) धा to have, क and टाप affs.; or शत the same, धाच, aff. शतधामन् m. (-मन्) VISHNU'U. E. शत a hundred, (i. e. many,) धामन् body; being multiplied in as many shapes as the creation exhibits.

शतधार mfn. (-धः-धौरः) 1. Flowing in many streams. 2. Having many edges. n. (-रः) The thunder-bolt. E. शत, धार an edge, टच् added.

शतधृति m. (धृतिः) 1. BRAHMA'. 2. INDRA. 3. Heaven. E. शत, धृति sacrifice.

शतपद m. (-पदः) A lotus in general, (*Nelumbium speciosum* or *Nymphaea nelumbo*) m. (-पदः) 1. A peacock. 2. The Sa'ras or Indian crane. 3. A wood-pecker. 4. A parrot, the king-parrot or Loerry. f. (-पदा) A woman. E. शत a hundred, पद a leaf or feather.

शतपञ्चक m. (-ञ्चः) The wood-pecker. E. कन् added to the last, q. v.

शतपञ्चिक mfn. (-ञ्चः-ञ्ची-ञ्चिकः) Following a variety of paths or doctrines.

E. शत a hundred, पञ्चन् a road and figurly. a doctrine, aff. विक्रन्। शतपदी f. (-दी) A centipede, jaulus. E. शत a hundred, पद a foot, जौष् aff.

शतपञ्च n. (-ञ्चः) The white lotus. E. शत hundred, (leaves), and पञ्च a lotus.

शतपञ्चन् m. (-ञ्चनः) A bamboo. E. शत a hundred or many, पञ्चन् a joint.

शतपञ्चा f. (-ञ्चा) 1. Bent grass, (*Panicum dactylon*). 2. Orris root. 3. The wife of S'UKRA. 4. Day of full-moon in the month of A'shwini.

E. शत a hundred, पञ्चन् a joint or period, जौष् aff.

शतपञ्चिका f. (-ञ्चिकः) 1. Bent grass or Du'rba'. 2. Orris root. 3. Barley. E. कन् fem. form, added to the last.

शतपञ्चे न m. (-ञ्चः) The planet VENUS or its regent. E. शतपञ्चा the wife of S'UKRA, ईश lord.

शतधाद् f. (धाद् or -पात) A centipede. E. शत a hundred, पाद a foot.

शतपञ्चिका f. (-ञ्चिकः) 1. A medicinal root, commonly Kákoli. 2. A centipede. E. शत a hundred, पाद a foot or root, कप aff., fem. form.

शतपञ्चम् m. (-ञ्चमः) The poet BHA'RAVI, the author of the KIRATA'RJUNIYAM. f. (-ञ्चमः) A sort of dill or fennel, (*Anethum sowa*.) "सुखका!"

शतपञ्चिका f. (-ञ्चिकः) Anethum sowa. E. कन् fem. form, added to the last.

शतपीत्र m. (-नः) A sieve.

शतपीत्रक m. (-कः) Fistula in ano with many external openings.

शतपीरक m. (-कः) A kind of sugar-cane.

शतप्रास m. (-सः) A flower, (*Nerium odorum*.) E. शत a hundred, प्रास a dart, to which the leaves are compared.

शतपञ्चज् f. (-ञ्चकः) One of the lunar asterisms : see the next.

शतपञ्चि f. (-ञ्चि) The twenty-fifth of the Nakshatras or lunar mansions, containing 100 stars, one of which is Aquarii. E. शत a hundred, भिषज् to cure, aff. उ; requiring many physicians; as the Hindus say DHANWANTARI himself can not cure any person affected with disease, whilst the moon is in this asterism. [मौरु timid.

शतभीक f. (-भीकः) Arabian jasmine, (*J. zambac*). E. शत a hundred, (dangers.)

शतमख m. (-खः) 1. INDRA. 2. An owl. E. शत, मख a sacrifice : the performance of a hundred As'hwa-mé'dhas obtaining this situation.

शतमन्तु m. (-न्तः) INDRA. E. शत a hundred, मन् a sacrifice : see the last. शतमान mn. (-नः-नः) 1. A pala of silver. 2. An A'dhaka or measure so termed. E. शत a hundred, मान measure. [a killer.

शतमारिन् m. (-रौ) A man who has killed a hundred others. E. शत, मारिन्

शतमार्ज m. (-र्जः) An armourer, a cutler. E. शत a hundred, (many weapons,) and मार्ज who cleans.

शतमुख mfn. (-खः-खौ-खः) 1. Having a hundred mouths. 2. Having a hundred openings. f. (-खौ) A brush or broom. E. शत, मुख mouth.

शतमूली f. (-लौ) A plant, (*Asparagus racemosus*.) E. शत a hundred or many, मूल a root, fem. aff. जौष्; also with कन् added शतमूलिका!

शतयष्टि k m. (-ष्टः) A necklace of 100 strings. E. शत a hundred, यष्टि a string, कन् added.
