

शर्करिण् mfn. (-लः-का-लं) Abounding in stony or gravelly particles, (a spot, a place.) E. शर्करा gravel and श्लक् aff.

शर्करो f. (-रो) 1. A river. 2. A girdle.

शर्क् r. 1st cl. (शर्क्ति) To wound or kill. [शर्क् to fart, aff. शर्क् ।]

शर्क् mn. (-र्कः-र्क) Farting, a fart. m. (-र्कः) 1. Strength. 2. Multitude. E.

शर्क्क mfn. (-र्कः-का-र्क) Causing flatulence. m. (-र्कः) Any leguminous grain or pulse, as beans, &c. E. शर्क् farting and क्वा to let go or loose, aff. शर्क् ।

शर्क् r. 1st cl. (शर्क्ति) 1. To go. 2. To hurt, to injure.

शर्क्क mfn. (-र्कः-दा-र्क) Conferring prosperity, making happy, propitious. E. शर्क्न् and द who or what gives.

शर्क्न् mfn. (-र्का-र्का-र्क) Happy, glad. n. (-र्क) Happiness, pleasure. m. (-र्का) A name or appellation common to and proper for Bra'hmans. E. श्च् to injure or destroy, (ill fortune,) क्निन् Una'di aff.

शर्क्कत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Lucky, auspicious. E. शर्क्न् and क्तुप् aff.

शर्क् r. 1st cl. (शर्क्ते) 1. To move, to shake, to tremble or stir. 2. To cover. (शर्क्ति) To go, to move to or towards. r. 10th cl. (शर्क्कति-ते) To praise.

शर्क् mn. (-र्कः-लं) The quill of a porcupine. m. (-र्कः) 1. A name of BERINGI, S'IVA's attendant. 2. BRAHMA'. 3. A kind of field. 4. A dart, a spear. 5. A stake. 6. A camel. E. श्च् to go, aff. शर्क् ।

शर्क्क m. (-र्कः) A spider. E. श्च् to go, aff. वृन् । [शर्क्क ।]

शर्क्क m. (-र्कः) 1. A king. 2. A sort of salt. E. श्च् to go, Una'di aff.

शर्क्कट m. (-र्कः) A cart-load, considered as twenty times one hundred Palas. E. श्च् to injure, aff. च्चटन् and the र changed to ल् ।

शर्क्कट mfn. (-र्कः-टुः-टु) Unripe, moist, (as fruit) m. (-र्कः) A kind of root. E. श्च् to go, च्चटुप् aff.

शर्क्कवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) 1. Shooting arrows. 2. Set with stakes. 3. Harassed with difficulties, &c. E. शर्क्क and क्तुप् aff.

शर्क्कवारङ्ग n. (-र्कः) The part by which an arrow or the like lodged in the body is to be laid hold of for its extraction. E. शर्क्क, and वारङ्ग the place of seizure.

शर्क्कशास्त्र n. (-र्कः) That part of Surgery which treats of the extraction of extraneous substances lodged in the body. E. शर्क्क, शास्त्र science.

शर्क्कारि m. (-र्कः) YUDHIS'T'HIRA. E. शर्क्क the prince, and चरि an enemy.

शर्क्कौडार m. (-र्कः) 1. Extraction of foreign substances from the body. 2. Cleansing or purifying a new house. E. शर्क्क, उडार taking away.

शर्क्क m. (-र्कः) A frog. n. (-र्कः) Bark, rind. E. श्च् to go, लक् aff. ; or शर्क्क-

शर्क्कयान n. (-र्कः) The litter or bed on which a dead body is carried to be burnt. E. शर्क्क a corpse, and यान a vehicle.

शर्क्क m. (-र्कः) 1. A barbarian, one inhabiting the mountainous districts of India, and wearing the feathers of the peacock, &c. as decorations. 2. Water. 3. A name of S'IVA. 4. The hand. 5.
