

शास्त्रातिक्रम m. (-नः) Behaving ill or immorally, transgressing, acting contrary to the S'hāstras. E. शास्त्र and अतिक्रम surpassing.

शास्त्रानुष्ठान n. (-नं) Following the S'ha'stras, conforming to the law or ritual, &c. E. शास्त्र, and अनुष्ठान conforming.

शास्त्रानुष्ठित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Who or what obeys or follows sacred institutes; &c. 2. Established or authorised by the S'hāstras. E. शास्त्र, and अनुष्ठित following. [following.]

शास्त्रानुसार m. (-रः) Conformity to sacred ordinances. E. शास्त्र, अनुसार

शास्त्रामित्र mfn. (-त्रः-त्रा-त्रं) Learned, versed in the S'hāstras. E. शास्त्र, and मित्र who knows.

शास्त्रिन् m. (-स्त्री) A Paṇ'd'it, a teacher of holy science, or one skilled in it. E. शास्त्र as above, and इनि aff.

शास्त्रीय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Scriptural, authorised by or conformable to sacred institutes. E. शास्त्र, and इ aff. [E. शास्त्र, and उक्त said.]

शास्त्रीक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Said or declared in a work of sacred authority.

शास्त्र mfn. (-स्त्रः-स्त्रा-स्त्रं) 1. To be regulated or ordained, to be enforced, to be provided for by any act of government or judicature. 2. To be advised. 3. Punishable, deserving punishment. E. शास् to govern, aff. यत् ।

श्रि (ञ) श्रिञ् r. 5th cl. (श्रिञ्ति श्रिञ्ते) 1. To make thin or small. 2. To whet, to sharpen. 3. To excite. 4. To be attentive.

श्रि m. (-श्रिः) 1. S'IVA. 2. Auspiciousness, good fortune. 3. Peace, composure, calm. E. श्रि to whet, or श्रि to destroy, aff. क् ।

श्रिष्या f. (-या) 1. A tree, (Dalbergia Sisu.) 2. The Asoka tree. E. श्रिष्य quick, or श्रिष्य the head or top; या to cherish, or पत् to fall, &c., aff. क or ड, deriv. irr.

श्रिक्नु mfn. (-क्नुः-क्नुः-क्नुः) Idle, lazy, following no business or profession.

श्रिक्य n. (-क्यं) Bee's wax; also श्रिक्यकं and सिक्यकं ।

श्रिक्य n. (-क्यं-क्या) 1. The string or loop suspended from either end of a pole or yoke to receive the burthen. 2. The burthen so carried. 3. The strings of a balance. E. श्रिञ् to fall, Unádi aff. यत्; श्रि substituted for the root, and कृत् augment.

श्रिक्याधार m. (-रः) The hook or eye at each end of a pole or beam, to which the strings of a yoke or balance are fastened. E. श्रिक्या as above, and आधार receptacle. [a loop, and इतच् aff.]

श्रिक्यित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Suspended or carried in a sort of loop. E. श्रिक्य

श्रिच् r. 1st cl. (श्रिचते) To learn, to acquire science.

श्रिचक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) A learner, a teacher. E. श्रिच् to learn, खुल् aff.

श्रिचण n. (-णं) 1. Learning. 2. Teaching, instruction. [aff.]

श्रिचणोय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) To be taught or learnt. E. श्रिच् to learn, अनौयर्

श्रिचा f. (-चा) 1. One of the six Ve'da'ngas or sciences attached to the Ve'das: the proper pronunciation of the vocal sounds which occur in them, as explained by PA'N'INI. 2. A plant, (Bignonia Indica.) 3. Learning, study, the acquisition of knowledge. 4. Modesty, humility. E. श्रिच् to learn, affs. चच् and टाप् ।

श्रिचाकर m. (-रः) 1. VYA'SA. 2. An instructor. E. श्रिचा the science of pronunciation, and कर making.

श्रिचानर m. (-रः) An epithet of INDRA.

श्रिचाशक्ति f. (-क्तिः) Dexterity, skill. E. श्रिचा discipline, and शक्ति power.

श्रिचित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Skilful, clever, conversant. 2. Modest, diffident. 3. Disciplined, exercised. 4. Tame, trained, (as an animal.) 5. Docile. 6. Studied, learned. E. श्रिचा studying, इतच् aff.; or श्रिच् to study, aff. क् । [तव्य aff.]

श्रिचितय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) To be taught or learnt. E. श्रिच् to learn, and श्रिचित्वाचर m. (-रः) A pupil, a scholar. E. श्रिचित study, (by whom,) and चचर a letter. [यत् aff.]

श्रिद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्यं) 1. To be taught, teachable. E. श्रिच् to learn,

श्रिद्यमाच m. (-चः) A pupil.

श्रिष् (इ) r. 1st cl. (श्रिष्ठति) To go, to move or approach.

श्रिष्ण्ड m. (-ण्डः) 1. The tail of a peacock. 2. Locks of hair left on the

crown or the sides of the head, at the period of tonsure in children: see the next. E. श्रिष्ण्ड a peacock or any crested object, चच् to be or belong to, ड aff. and the form irr.

श्रिष्ण्डक m. (-कः) 1. Locks of hair left at the time of tonsure; three or five locks left in children in general, or especially those of the military class, in which latter case, the hair is left in a semicircular patch on each side of the head, covering rather more than the temporal bones, and following much the same outline: see काकपच्च. 2. The crest or lock of hair left on the crown of the head. 3. A peacock's tail. E. श्रिष्ण्ड a crest, षण्ड an egg, and कच् pleonasm, or aff. of comparison; also श्रिष्ण्डक and श्रिष्ण्ड ।

A plant, (Achyranthes aspera.) 4. A stronghold, a hill-fort. 5. The lapwing. f. (-रिष्णी) 1. A form of metre, a species of the class Atyashti' metre or verse of four lines of 17 syllables each. 2. श्रिष्ण्डाधरज n. (-जं) A peacock's feather.

श्रिष्ण्डाधर m. (-रः) A peacock. E. श्रिष्ण्ड a crest, and धर who has.

श्रिष्ण्डालु n. (-लु) A carrot, a turnip, or any root with a tuft of leaves growing from it. E. श्रिष्ण्ड a crest, and मूल a root.

श्रिष्ण्डावत् m. (-वान्) 1. A name of AGNI or fire. 2. The personified descending node. 3. A lamp. f. (-वती) A plant, (Sansevieria zeylanica.) E. श्रिष्ण्ड a crest, and मत्तुप् poss. aff.

श्रिष्ण्डावर m. (-रः) The jack-fruit tree (Artocarpus integrifolia.)

श्रिष्ण्डावल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Crested, pointed. m. (-लः) A peacock. f. (-ला) A flower, (Celosia cristata.) E. श्रिष्ण्ड a crest, and वल्च् aff.
