

श्रीर्ष n. (-र्ष) The head. E. See शिरस् for which it is substituted.

श्रीर्षक n. (-क) 1. A helmet. 2. The skull. 3. The head. 4. Judgment, award, sentence, the fruit or result of judicial investigation. m. (-कः) Ráhu, the personified ascending node. E. कन् added to the last.

श्रीर्षकश्च mfn. (-श्चः-श्चा-श्च) 1. Staying in or on the head. 2. Abiding by an award, agreeing to submit to the penalty imposed by it. E. श्रीर्षक, and च्च who stays.

श्रीर्षचानिन् mfn. (-नी-तिनी-ति) 1. Beheading, decapitating. 2. Striking or injuring the head. E. श्रीर्ष the head, च्चन् to strike, aff. णिनि ।

श्रीर्षच्छेद m. (-दः) Decapitating. E. श्रीर्ष, च्छेद cutting; also श्रीर्षच्छेदन ।

श्रीर्षच्छेदक mfn. (-कः-की-क) Meriting decapitation. E. श्रीर्ष the head, च्छेद cutting, aff. टक् ।

श्रीर्षच्छेदिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) Who or what decapitates. E. श्रीर्ष, च्छेदिन् who cuts.

श्रीर्षच्छेद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्य) Meriting death by decapitation. E. श्रीर्ष the head, च्छेद्य to be cut off.

श्रीर्षण्य n. (-ण्यं) A helmet. m. (-ण्यः) Clean and unentangled hair. E. श्रीर्षन् substituted for शिरस्, and ण्य aff.

श्रीर्षरच n. (-च) A helmet. E. श्रीर्ष the head, and रच preserving.

श्रील r. 1st cl. (श्रीलति) 1. To meditate, to consider, to reflect profoundly and abstractedly. 2. To worship, to adore. r. 1st and 10th cls. (श्रीलति श्रीलयति-ते) 1. श्रील mfn. (-लः-ला-ल) 1. Possessed of, endowed with, practising, versed in, &c. 2. Behaviour, conduct. 3. Well-behaved, well-disposed. m. (-लः-लं) 1. Nature, quality. 2. Disposition, inclination. 3. Good conduct or disposition, steady and uniform observance of law and morals. 4. Beauty. m. (-लः) A large snake. E. श्रील to meditate, to learn, &c., aff. लच्; or श्री to sleep, and लक् Una'di aff.

श्रीलल n. (-ल) 1. Disposition, quality. 2. Conversancy. E. श्रील, and ल added; also with लल्, श्रीलला ।

श्रीलन n. (-न) 1. Careful study of the S'ha'stras or sacred writings. 2. Serving, honouring. 3. Putting on. E. श्रील to meditate, &c., aff. ल्युट् । [conduct, सतुप् poss. aff.]

श्रीलवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Of a good or amiable disposition. E. श्रील good

श्रीलवृत्त mfn. (-त्तः-चा-त्त) Moral, steady and uniform in good behaviour. E. श्रील, वृत्त practice.

श्रीलसम्पन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्न) Well conducted, of proper conduct or disposition. E. श्रील, and सम्पन्न abounding with.

श्रीलित mfn. (-तः-ता-त) 1. Skilled, learned, conversant, exercised. 2. Having, endowed with. 3. Made or consisting of. 4. Visited. E. श्रील to learn, &c., aff. क्त ।

श्रीलन् m. (-न) A large snake, the Boa. E. श्री to sleep, क्तान्प् Una'di aff.

श्रीलन n. (-ल) 1. An aquatic plant, (Vallisneria.) 2. Benzoin or Storax. E. श्री to sleep, (on the water,) लच् aff., and the vowel unchanged; also शील, &c.

श्रीशुमार m. (-रः) A porpoise; more usually शिशुमार ।

श्री Ind. 1. Handsomely, brilliantly, elegantly. 2. Well, right. E. शुम् to be splendid, aff. ङ ।

श्रीक् r. 1st. cl. (श्रीकति) 1. To go. 2. To touch.

श्रीक m. (-कः) 1. A parrot. 2. The son of VYA'SA, the author or narrator of the Bha'gavat. 3. The minister of RA'VAN'A. 4. The Sirisha tree. 5. A plant, commonly Se'ya'la ka'nta'. n. (-कं) 1. A drug and perfume, commonly Gaunt'ha'la. 2. Cloth, clothes. 3. The ends or hem of a cloth. 4. A turban, a helmet. 5. A plant, (Bignonia Indica.) E. शुक् to shine, कक् Una'di aff., and the radical final rejected.

श्रीकच्छद n. (-दं) A fragrant root, of which various kinds are said to be known. E. शुक् a parrot, and च्छद a cover or wing.

श्रीकजिह्वा f. (-ह्वा) A plant, commonly Su'ya'-Tho'ntee or parrot's beak. E. शुक् a parrot, and जिह्वा the tongue. [तृक् tree.]

श्रीकतल m. (-तः) The Siri'sha, (Acacia Sirisha.) E. शुक् the same, and

श्रीकदेव m. (-वः) The son of VYA'SA : see शुक्. E. शुक्, and देव divine.

श्रीकद्रुम m. (-नः) The Siri'sha tree : see the last.

श्रीकनामा f. (-मा) A plant; see श्रीकजिह्वा ।

श्रीकनास m. (-सः) 1. A tree, (Bignonia Indica.) 2. Another tree, (Sesbana grandiflora.) E. शुक्, and नास the nose, the flowers being compared to a parrot's beak.

श्रीकपितामह m. (-हः) The sage PARA'SARA, the father of VYA'SA, and grandfather of S'UKA. [colour.]

श्रीकपुच्छ m. (-च्छः) Sulphur. E. शुक् a parrot, पुच्छ the tail; of similar

श्रीकपुच्छक n. (-क) A perfume and medicinal root, commonly Gaunt'hiála. E. शुक् a parrot, पुच्छ the tail, कन् aff. of comparison. [beloved.]

श्रीकप्रिया f. (-या) The rose-apple, (Eugenia jambu.) E. शुक् a parrot, प्रिया

श्रीकम् Ind. Quickly.

श्रीकवर्धन n. (-हं) Ga'nt'ha'la', a perfume. E. शुक् a parrot, वर्ध a tail.

श्रीकवल्लभ m. (-भः) The pomegranate. E. शुक् a parrot, and वल्लभ beloved.

श्रीकवाह m. (-हः) KA'MADEVA. E. शुक् a parrot, and वाह who is borne.

श्रीकानन m. (-नः) The pomegranate. E. शुक् a parrot, कानन eating.

श्रीकानना f. (-ना) A plant, commonly Su'ya'-Tho'ntee. E. शुक् a parrot, कानन the face.

श्रीक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Sour, acid. 2. Pure, clean. 3. Harsh, hard. 4. Lovely. 5. United, joined. n. (-कं) 1. Flesh. 2. Sour-gruel. 3. Vinegar, acid, or an acid preparation made from roots or fruits, by steeping them in oil and salt, drying them, and then leaving them in water, where they undergo the acetous fermentation; the fluid produce is used as vinegar. 4. Crabbed or harsh speech. 5. A hymn of the Ve'das. f. (-कः) A sort of sorrel. E. शुक् to be pure, &c., aff. क्त ।

A curl or feather on a horse's neck or breast. 8. A weight of two Karshas or half a Pala. 9. A disease of the cornea, formation of specks on it. E. शुक् to sorrow, &c., aff. क्तिन् ।

श्रीक्तिका f. (-का) 1. A pearl-oyster. 2. A sort of dock or sorrel. E. शुक्ति as above, or शुक्त sour, कन् added, fem. form.

श्रीक्तिज n. (-ज) A pearl. E. शुक्ति the oyster, and ज born.

श्रीक्तिपुट n. (-ट) The pearl oyster-shell. E. शुक्ति, पुट a bag or sheathe.

श्रीक्तिपेशी f. (-शी) The envelope of the pearl or pearl-oyster-shell. E. शुक्ति, and देशी a covering.

श्रीक्तिवधू f. (-धूः) Mother of pearl or the pearl oyster. E. शुक्ति, and वधू wife or female; in which the pearl, it is supposed, is bred.

श्रीक्तिमत् m. (-मान्) One of the seven principal mountains or mountainous ranges of India. E. शुक्ति a pearl-oyster, and सतुप् aff.

श्रीक्तिबीज n. (-ज) A pearl. E. शुक्ति the oyster, and बीज a seed.

श्रीक्तिस्पर्श m. (-शः) Dusky spots on a pearl, causing it to be of little value. E. शुक्ति a pearl, and स्पर्श contact.

श्रीकृ m. (-कृः) 1. The planet VENUS or its regent, the son of BHRIGU, and preceptor of the Daityas or Titans. 2. A name of fire. 3. The month Jye'sht'ha, (April-May.) n. (-कृं) 1. Semen virile. 2. The essence of anything. 3. A morbid affection of the iris, change of colour, ulceration, &c. accompanied by imperfect vision. E. शुक् to grieve, &c., Una'di aff. रक्, deriv. irr.

श्रीकृकर mfn. (-रः-रा-र) Producing semen, spermatic. m. (-रः) The marrow of the bones. E. श्रीकृ seed, and कर what makes.

श्रीकृभुज m. (-भुक्) A peacock. E. श्रीकृ semen, भुज to eat, aff. क्तिप् ।

श्रीकृभू f. (-भूः) The marrow of the bones. E. श्रीकृ semen, भू being, क्तिप् aff.

श्रीकृल mfn. (-लः-ला-ल) Spermatic, augmenting the seminal secretion. f.
