- सदाचार m. (-रः) 1. The traditionary observances of the Hindu castes, as preserved in the land lying between the Saraswati and Drishadwati rivers. 2. Virtuous conduct. E. सत् pure, virtuous, and आचार observance. [व्युत् aff.]
- सदातन mfn. (-नः-नी-नं) Eternal. m. (-नः) VISHN'U. E. सदा always, सदातोया f. (-या) 1. A plant, (Mimosa octandra.) 2. An overflowing river. E. सदा always, तोय water.
- सदात्मन् mfn. (-त्मा-त्मा-त्) Good, virtuous. E. सत्, and आत्मन् self.
- सदादान n. (-नं) Liberality, munificence. m. (-नः) 1. The elephant of INDRA. 2. A name of GANES'S. 3. An elephant in rut. E. सदा always, दान giving, or the ichor that exudes from the elephant's temples. [happiness.]
- सदानन्द mfn. (-न्दः-न्दा-न्दं) Always happy. m. (-न्दः) S'IVA. E. सदा, आनन्द सदानन्त m. (-न्तः) A wagtail. E. सदा always, नन्त a dancer. "खड्गने ।"
- सदानौरवहा f. (-हा) A small river in the north of Bengal. E. सदा always, नौर water, वह bearing. [सदा always, नौर water.]

- सदायोगिन् m. (-गो) VISHN'U. E. सदा always, योग union by meditation, सदाशिव m. (-वः) S'IVA. E. सदा always, शिव auspicious.
- सदाश्रित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Attached or belonging to the virtuous, pure, good, lovely, &c. 2. Always connected with or dependent on. E. सत् good, &c., or सदा always, and आश्रित connected.
- सदुत्तर n. (-रः) A proper or good reply. E. सत्, and उत्तर answer.
- सदृच् mfn. (-चः-चा-चं) 1. Like, similar. 2. Conformable, fit, proper. 3. Worthy, becoming. E. स for सम् same, दृच् to see, क्स aff.
- सदृश् mfn. (-श्) Like, similar. E. स for सम same, दृश् to see, aff. क्तिप् ।
- सदृश mfn. (-शः-शी-शं) 1. Like, resembling, similar. 2. Fit, proper, right. E. स for सम the same, दृश् to see, aff. टक् । [ल, सदृशल ।]
- सदृशता f. (-ता) Likeness, sameness. E. तल् added to the last ; also with सदृश mfn. (-शः-शी-शं) 1. Near, proximate. 2. Of the same country or place. 3. Having a country. E. स for समान the same, देश country.
- सदृशति f. (-तिः) 1. Felicity or fortune. 2. Good conduct. E. सत्, गति going.
- सद्गुण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) 1. Good, pure, virtuous. 2. Excellent, eminent. E. सत्, गुण quality. [being, हेतु cause.]
- सद्हेतु m. (-तुः) (In logic,) The co-existence of cause and effect. E. सत् सद्भाव m. (-वः) 1. A pure or holy disposition or nature. 2. A good temper. 3. Amiability, kindly feeling. 4. The quality or nature of being, entity. 5. The property of goodness. E. सत्, and भाव quality.

- सद्यःकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Done promptly or quickly. n. (-तं) A name, an appellation. E. सद्यस् instantly, कृत made.
- सद्यःशोधा f. (-धा) Cowach, (Carpopogon pruriens.) E. सद्यस् instantly, शोधा a swelling.
- सद्यस् Ind. 1. Instantly, momentarily, at the moment, in an instant. 2. To day. E. स for सम् the same, and द्यस् for अहन् a day.
- सद्यस्काल mfn. (-कालः-कालः-कालः) New, recent. E. सद्यस् in the moment, काल् aff.
- सद्यस्काल m. (-कालः) Present time.
- सद्युवती f. (-ती) A virtuous maiden. E. सत्, and युवती a young woman.
- सद्योजात m. (-तः) A calf. E. सद्यस् in a moment, and जात born.

- सद्गु mfn. (-गुः-गुः-गुः) 1. Resting, staying. 2. Going. E. सद् to go or sit, सद्गु mfn. (-गुः-शा-शं) Of high birth, of a good race. E. सत्, वंश a race.
- सद्गुण m. (-णः) A village. E. सत् good, वस् to abide, अद्यच् aff.

- सद्गुण mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Wealthy, rich. E. स with, धन wealth.
- सद्गुणन् mfn. (-न्ना-न्ना-न्ना) 1. Like, equal, resembling. 2. Of the same sect or caste, performing like duties. 3. Of the same or similar properties. E. स for समान same, धर्म merit, practice, and अन्निच् aff.
- सद्गुणचारिणी f. (-णी) A wife, one married with religious rites. E. स with, (her husband,) धर्म duty, चारिणी who proceeds.
- सद्गुण्यन् mfn. (-न्नी-न्नी-न्नी) Observing the same customs or laws. f. (-न्नीणी) A wife wedded according to the ritual of the Ve'das. E. स same or with, धर्म virtue or duty, इति aff. [husband.]
- सद्गुणा f. (-वा) Wife, whose husband is living. E. स for सह with, धर्म a सद्गुण m. (-धिः) A name of AGNI or fire. E. स with, धा to have, aff. क्ति ।

- सन m. (-नः-नी) The flapping of an elephant's ears. m. (-नः) 1. A plant, commonly Ghanta'parali. 2. A tree, (Pentaptera tomentosa.) f. (-नी) 1. GAURI'. 2. Light, lustre. E. धन् to give, or serve, aff. अच् ।
- सनक m. (-कः) 1. One of the companions of VISHN'U, or four sons of BRAHMA', inhabiting the Janaloka. 2. Name of an inspired legislator. E. धन् to serve, वृन् aff. [give, aff. अति ।]
- सनत् m. (-नत्) BRAHMA'. Ind. Always, perpetually. E. सन् to serve or सनकुमार m. (-रः) 1. One of the four sons of BRAHMA', and eldest of the progenitors of mankind. 2. One of the twelve emperors of India according to the Jainas. E. सनत् always, कुमार a youth : i. e. continent ; retaining the purity of that age, or being devoid of human passion ; otherwise, सनत् BRAHMA', and कुमार son.

- सनपत्नी f. (-नी) A plant, (Marsilea quadrifolia.) E. सन the Asana or pentaptera, पर्ण a leaf ; more usually असनपत्नी ।
- सनसन् n. (-नः) 1. Excrement, ordure. 2. S'IVA's trident. 3. Crystal. E. धन् to give, असन् aff.
- सनसृच् n. (-च) Packthread, or a net made of it. E. See शणसृच् ।
- सना Ind. Always, eternally, perpetually. E. धन् to serve, आच् aff.
- सनातन mfn. (-नः-नी-नं) 1. Eternal, continual, perpetual. 2. Firm, fixed, permanent. 3. Primeval. m. (-नः) 1. VISHN'U. 2. S'IVA. 3. BRAHMA'. 4. A guest of the Manes, or one who is to be fed whenever he chooses to attend the obsequial ceremonies or S'hra'ddhas. f. (-नी) 1. The goddess LAKSHMI'. 2. A name of DURGA. 3. SARASWATI.
