

सर्वत्रग mfn. (-गः-गाने) All-pervading, going every where. m. (-गः) Air, wind. E. सर्वत्र every where, गम् to go, उ aff.

सर्वत्रगामिन् m. (-नो) Air, wind. E. सर्वत्र always, गामिन् going.

सर्वथा Ind. f. (-था) 1. In all ways, by all means. 2. Assuredly, certainly. 3. Exceeding, mostly. 4. Always. E. सर्व all, थाल् aff.

सर्वदमन mfn. (-नः-नाने) All-subduing, irresistible. m. (-नः) BHARATA, the son of S'AKUNTALA. E. सर्व all, दमन taming.

सर्वदृशिन् mfn. (-शी-शिनो-शि) All-seeing. m. (-शी) A Budd'ha in general. E. सर्व all, and दृशिन् seeing.

सर्वदा Ind. Always, at all times. E. सर्व all, and दाच् aff.

सर्वदुःखक्षय m. (-यः) Final emancipation from transmigration. E. सर्व all, दुःख pain, and क्षय destruction. [मयट् aff.]

सर्वदेवमय mfn. (-यः-यो-य) Made of or comprising all the gods. E. सर्वदेव, सर्वदेवमुख m. (-खः) A name of AGNI or fire. E. सर्व all, देव a deity, and मुख mouth; being the medium of oblations to the gods.

सर्वधन n. (-ने) 1. Whole wealth or property. 2. (In arithmetic,) Total of a sum in progression. E. सर्व, and धन wealth.

सर्वधर्मविद् m. (-विद् or-वित्) One who knows the duties of all tribes and classes. E. सर्व, धर्म duty, विद् who knows.

सर्वधारी f. (-री) The twenty-second year of the cycle. E. सर्व all, धृ to hold, ऋच् and ङीष् affs.

सर्वधुरावह m. (-हः) An ox fit for any sorts of carriage. E. सर्व all, धुर a burden, आह् before वह् to bear, aff. ऋच् ।

सर्वधुरीण m. (-णः) An ox, &c. fit for any carriage or draught. E. सर्व all, धुर a burden, ख aff. [तल् aff.]

सर्वनामता f. (-ता) The quality or condition of a pronoun. E. सर्वनाम and सर्वनामन् n. (-मः) A pronoun. E. सर्व, and नामन् name. [त्रुक्त्त.]

सर्वनाश m. (-शः) Total destruction, destruction of all. E. सर्व, नाश des-सर्वन्दम m. (-मः) BHARATA. E. सर्व all, दम् to tame or subdue, खच् aff.

सर्वपथ m. (-थः) Every way, every direction. सर्व, पथ for पथिन् a path.

सर्वपथीन mfn. (-नः-नाने) In or of every road or direction, (moving, passing, &c.) E. सर्वपथ, and ख aff. [अङ् and टाप् ।

सर्वपा f. (-पा) The wife of the Daitya BALI. E. सर्व all, पा to drink, affs.

सर्वपूर्ण n. (-त्वं) Entire completion or fulness, complete preparation or provision. E. सर्व all, and पूर्ण fulness.

सर्वप्रिय mfn. (-यः-या-य) 1. Generally or universally beloved. 2. Generally friendly, loving all. E. सर्व all, and प्रिय dear.

सर्वभक्ष mfn. (-चः-चा-च) Omnivorous, eating all or any thing. f. (-चा) A female goat. E. सर्व all, and भक्ष who eats.

सर्वभक्ष्य mfn. (-क्ष्यः-क्ष्या-क्ष्य) 1. Eating any thing or all things, (a child.) 2. All-devouring, omnivorous. E. सर्व, and भक्ष्य edible.

सर्वभाव m. (-वः) Whole disposition, all one's thoughts and purpose. E. सर्व, and भाव disposition. [all, भूत an element.]

सर्वभूत n. Plu. (-तानि) 1. All the elements. 2. All created things. E. सर्व सर्वभूतकृत् mn. (-कृत्) 1. The maker of all things. 2. The cause of all elements or beings. E. सर्वभूत, and कृत् who or what makes.

सर्वभूतमय mfn. (-यः-यो-य) Comprising or comprehending all elementary matter. m. (-यः) The supreme pervading spirit. E. सर्वभूत, मयट् aff.

सर्वभूतस्थ mfn. (-स्थः-स्था-स्थ) Present in all elements or beings. E. सर्व all, भूत an element, and स्थ what stays; also सर्वभूतस्थित, &c.

सर्वभूतात्मन् m. (-त्मा) Universal, all-pervading spirit. E. सर्वभूत an element, and आत्मन् soul. [supports.]

सर्वभृत् mfn. (-भृत्) Cherishing or supporting all. E. सर्व, भृत् who or what सर्वभोगिन् mfn. (-गो-गिणो-गि) Enjoying all. E. सर्व, भोगिन् who enjoys.

सर्वभोगीण mfn. (-णः-णा-ण) Good or beneficial for all, to be enjoyed or possessed by all. E. सर्व, and भोग enjoyment, खच् aff.

सर्वमङ्गला f. (-ला) DURGA. E. सर्व all, मङ्गल auspicious.

सर्वमय mfn. (-यः-या-य) General, universal, comprehensive, comprehending. E. सर्व all, मयट् aff.

सर्वमही f. (-ही) The whole earth. E. सर्व, and मही earth.

सर्वमूला n. (-ला) A Cowrie or small coin represented by it. E. सर्व all, (of all things,) मूल price.

सर्वसूक्त m. (-क्तः) Time. E. सर्व all, (things,) सूक् to steal, वृन् aff.

सर्वरस m. (-सः) 1. Resin, the exudation of the pine or Sa'l. 2. A sort of of musical instrument, a kind of lute. 3. A learned man. 4. Saltness, salt, saline flavour or taste. E. सर्व all, रस taste, real or figurative.

सर्वरसोत्तम m. (-मः) The saline flavour, saltness, salt. E. सर्व all, रस a flavour, उत्तम best. [for the final.]

सर्वरात्र m. (-त्रः) The whole night. E. सर्व all, रात्रि night, ऋच् substituted

सर्वरीकर m. (-रः) The moon. E. सर्वरी for सर्वरी night, कर who makes.

सर्वरिक्ता f. (-ता) A plant, (Gmelina arborea.)

सर्वसुपरिवर्त्त m. (-त्तः) A year. E. सर्व all, ऋत् a season, परिवर्त्त a revolution.

सर्वला f. (-ला) An iron club. "नीमराले" E. सर्व all, ला to take, affs. ऋच् and टाप्; also read सर्वला and सर्वनी ।

सर्वलिङ्गिन् m. (-ङ्गि) A heretic, an impostor; one who not belonging to the orthodox faith, wears the dress, and assumes the character of an ascetic. E. सर्व all, लिङ्ग mark, (of sect or caste,) इनि aff.

सर्वलोक m. (-कः) The universe. E. सर्व, and लोक world.

सर्वलोह m. (-हः) An iron arrow. E. सर्व all, लोह iron. [a mistress.]

सर्ववह्ना f. (-भा) A disloyal or unchaste woman. E. सर्व all, and वह्ना सर्वविद् mfn. (-वित्) Omniscient, all-wise. E. सर्व, and विद् who knows.

सर्ववेद m. (-दः) A Bra'hman who has read the four Védas. E. सर्व all, वेद the Vēda, and ऋच् or उक् aff.; the effects of the aff. being subsequently rejected.

सर्ववेदस् m. (-दाः) A man who gives away all his property to the priests who have been employed by him at particular sacrifices, of which such a destination of the principal's whole wealth is an essential part. E. सर्व all, विद् to gain, causal form, aff. ऋच् ।

सर्ववेदिन् mfn. (-दो-दिनो-दि) Omniscient. E. सर्व, and वेदिन् who knows.

सर्ववेदिन् m. (-शी) An actor, a dancer. E. सर्व all, वेश dress, &c. इनि aff.

सर्वशस् Ind. 1. Wholly, universally. 2. On all sides. E. सर्व, शस् aff.

सर्वशान्तिकृत् m. (-कृत्) The sovereign of India, BHARATA. E. सर्व all, शान्ति tranquillity, and कृत् who effects.

सर्वशेष mfn. (-शेषः-शेष) 1. What remains of the whole. 2. What is to continue or to be added to all. E. सर्व, and शेष remainder.

सर्वसङ्गत mfn. (-तः-ता-त) United or meeting with universally. m. (-तः) A sort of rice of quick growth. E. सर्व all, (by all,) सङ्गत known.

सर्वसङ्ग्रह m. (-हः) 1. A general or universal collection. 2. Any collection. E. सर्व, and सङ्ग्रह collection.

सर्वसन्नहन n. (-नः) Assembling a complete army. E. सर्व all, (the parts, or elephants, chariots, horse, and foot,) सन्नहन arming.

सर्वसन्नाह m. (-हः) 1. The universal and pervading spirit. 2. Arming or assembling a complete army. E. सर्व, सन्नाह arming, accoutring.

सर्वसमता f. (-ता) 1. Sameness or identity with all things. 2. Equanimity, equal regard for all. E. सर्व, and समता sameness.

सर्वसह mfn. (-हः-हा-ह) All-enduring, bearing all things with patience and firmness. m. (-हः) Bdellium. "गुग्गुली" f. (-ली) The earth. E. सर्व all, सह to suffer, aff. ऋच् ।

सर्वसिद्धायै mfn. (-यै-यो-यै) Having every object attained, every wish gratified, &c. E. सर्व, and सिद्ध accomplished, अर्थ object.

सर्वसिद्धि f. (-द्धिः) Universal success or accomplishment of all. m. (-द्धिः) A tree, (Ægle marmelos.) E. सर्व all, सिद्धि completion.

सर्वस्व n. (-स्वः) 1. Whole property or possessions. 2. Substance, whole essence of anything. E. सर्व, and स्व own.

सर्वस्वदण्ड mfn. (-ण्डः-ण्डा-ण्ड) Fined in all one's property. n. (-ण्डः) Confiscation of property. E. सर्वस्व, and दण्ड punishment.

सर्वस्वहरण n. (-णः) Confiscation of a whole property. E. सर्वस्व, and हरण taking; also सर्वस्वहार, &c.

सर्वस्वामिन् m. (-सो) 1. A universal monarch. 2. The owner or master of all. E. सर्व, स्वामिन् a master.
