 हृन्मत् m. (-मान्) 1. The monkey chief HANUMA'N, the son of ANJANA, by PAVANA or the wind, the friend, ally and spy of RA'MACHANDRA, in his invasion of LANKA'. 2. A particular sort of monkey, (Simia sinica.) E. हृन् the jaw, and मतप् aff.; also with हृन्, हृन्मत् m. (-मान्).
 हृन्मूल n. (-लं) The root of the jaw or chin.
 हृन्मूलम् m. (-मः) Locked jaw, E. हृन्, and मूल stiffness.
 हृन्वृ m. (-वृः) A goblin, a demon, E. हृन् to kill, ऊणन् Una'di aff.

 हृन्म m. (-न्नः) A horse-dealer, a groom, a jockey, one who is a judge of the qualities of a horse, E. हृन्, and म् who knows.
 हृन्मता f. (-ता) Horsemanship, knowledge of horses and their management, E. तल् added to the last.
 हृन्दिषत् m. (-षन्) The buffalo, E. हृन्, and दिषत् foe.
 हृन् n. (-नं) A covered carriage. m. (-नः) A year, E. हृन् to go, ल्युट् aff.
 हृन्पुच्छ m. (-च्छः) A horse's tail. f. (-च्छा) A leguminous plant, (Glycine debilis.) E. हृन् a horse, पुच्छ the tail. [fond of.]
 हृन्प्रिय m. (-यः) Barley. f. (-या) The Kharju'ri tree, E. हृन् a horse, प्रिय हृन्मारक m. (-कः) A shrub, the fragrant oleander, (Nerium odorum.) E. हृन् a horse, मारक killer; also with मार the same, हृन्मार m. (-रः)।

 हृन्मेध m. (-धः) The sacrifice of a horse: see अश्वमेध. E. हृन्, and मेध sacrifice. [a vehicle.]
 हृन्वाहन m. (-नः) 1. The son of SŪRYA. 2. KŪVE'RA, E. हृन् a horse, वाहन हृन्वाहनसङ्कर m. (-रः) Mountain-ebony, the red sort. "रक्तकाञ्चने"।
 हृन्शाला f. (-ला) A stable for horses.
 हृन्शास्त्र n. (-स्त्रं) The art or science of training and managing horses.
 हृन्सङ्ग्रहण n. (-णं) The restraining or curbing of horses. [delighting.]
 हृन्यानन्द m. (-न्दः) Kidney-bean, (Phaseolus mungo.) E. हृन् horse, आनन्द हृन्यारि m. (-रिः) A shrub, (Nerium odorum.) E. हृन् a horse, अरि inimical.
 हृन्याहृद् m. (-हृद्) A horseman, a rider, E. हृन्, and आहृद् mounted on.
 हृन्यारोह m. (-हृद्) Riding, horsemanship, E. हृन्, and आरोह mounting.
 हृन्याशन f. (-ना) The gum Olibanum tree. E. हृन् a horse, and अशन food.
 हृन्येष्ट m. (-ष्टः) Barley.
 हृन्येत्तम m. (-मः) An excellent horse, E. हृन् a horse, and उत्तम best.
 हर mfn. (रः-रा or -रौ-रं) Who or what takes or seizes, carries or conveys, divides, removes, &c. m. (-रः) 1. SIVA. 2. AGNI. 3. An ass. 4. (In Arithmetic,) A divisor; also the denominator of a fraction. E. हृ to take, aff. अप्, अच् or टच्.
