हाहा m. (-हाः) A Gandharba, a demi-god of an inferior order, atten-

dant on KURVA and the other gods, and especially the chanter of their praises. Ind. An interjection of surprise, grief, or pain. ३. हा alas, interjection of sorrow, हा to abandon, क्तिप् aff.; or हा interjection repeated; also with चक्षु or चसुन् aff., हाहस् m. (-हाः).
