

karamardī

Su.Sū.38,73 (omitted in Bt.), Da.: karamardī ksīraphalā 'karamadī' iti loke. Śiva.Dr., phalavarga 11 (karamarda): karamardaṃ kaṅṭakīphalam iti candrikā, tad dvididhaṃ mahad alpam ca. tatra mahat prāyaśo grāmabhavam amlam ca. alpā tu karamardī vanajā madhurāmlaphalā iti ca vyācāste. See also Bt. on karamarda: karamarda is known as Carissa carandas Linn. and its wild kind called karamardikā is Carissa spinarum Linn.

karavīra

(1) Nerium indicum Miller = N. odorum Solander (HK; Bpn, guḍūcyādivarga 82-84; Nadk. 1, nr.1709; Na 1, nr.326; KB 2, p.1584-1586) (śvetapuṣpa karavīra);

(2) Thevetia peruviana (Pers.) K. Schum. = T. neriifolia Juss. (Bpn, guḍūcyādivarga 82-84; KB 2, p.1554-1556) (raktapuṣpa karavīra) (this species is a native of tropical America, now pantropic).

karikesara

(1) = vaḍava trapuṣa (or trapuṣa) (Da. on Su.Sū.46,216 and Ci.31,5);

(2) = kūsmāṇḍa (Da. on Su.Ci.18,29);

(3) = kūsmāṇḍabheda (Śivadāsa on Cakradatta, mūtrakṛcchra 26; Kusu-māvalī on Vṛnda's Siddhayoga 41,6);

(4) = karkatībheda (Da. on Su.Sū.9,4);

(5) = tiktatumbī (Kusumāvalī on Vṛnda's Siddhayoga 41,6);
