

जन्म-साफल्य (स्यं) 1. *n.* Attainment of the end of existence.

जन्मान्तर (रं) 1. *n.* Another birth.

जन्माश्रय (श्रः-श्र्या-श्र्यं) *a.* Born blind.

जन्माष्टमी(नी) 3. *f.* The dark half of *Bhādra*, birth-day of *Krishna*.

जन्मिन् (न्मि) 5. *m.* An animal.

जन्मेजय (यः) 1. *m.* Name of a king.

जन्य (न्यः) 1. *m.* A father; bridegroom's friend. *f.* A mother; a bridesmaid; happiness. *n.* War; rumour; a market; a portent. *a.* Being born; fit for all.

जन्मु (न्युः) 2. *m.* An animal or sentient being; *Brahmā*; fire.

जप् जपति 1. *a.* To speak to one's self; to meditate. उपजप् To divide.

जप (पः) 1. *m.* Muttering prayers, &c. *f.* The China rose.

जपन(नं) 1. *n.* Inaudible repetition of prayers, charms, &c.

जपनीय (यः-या-यं) *a.* That should be repeated mentally, or meditated.

जप.परायण (णः) 1. *m.* A sage, one devoted to meditation.

जप.माला (ला) 1. *f.* A rosary.

जप.यज्ञ(ज्ञः) 1. *m.* Muttering prayers.

जपित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Repeated inaudibly, meditated on.

जप्य (प्यः-प्या-प्यं) *a.* That should be repeated mentally.

जम् जभति, जभति 1. *a.* To copulate.

(-ङ) जभते, जभते 1. *d.* To yawn.

(क, इ) जभयति 10. *a.* To destroy.

जम् (ञ) जसति 1. *a.* To eat.

जम् *Aptote.* (*In compo.*) A wife.

जमदग्नि (ग्निः) 2. *m.* A sage, the father of *Purusharāma*.

जमन (नं) 1. *n.* Eating; a food.

जम्पती (ती) 3. *m. du.* Husband and wife. जम् and पति.

जम्बाल (लः-लं) 1. *m. n.* Mud, clay, an aquatic plant, *Pandanus*.

जम्बालिनी (नी) 3. *f.* A river.

जम्बोर (रः) 1. *m.* A lime.

जम्बोर (रः) 1. *m.* Common lime.

जम्बु (म्बुः-म्बु) 2. *m. n.* *Jambu-dvīpa*, the central division of the earth; a fabulous river, flowing from mount *Meru*. 2. *f.* The rose-apple. *f. n.* Its fruit.

जम्बुक(कः) 1. *m.* A jackal; *Varuna*; a low man; rose-apple.

जम्बु.द्वीप(पः) 1. *m.* The *Hindu's* central division of the world.

जम्बुसत् (मान्) 5. *m.* A monkey; a mountain. *f.* (सती) A nymph.

जम्बू (म्बुः) 3. *f.* Vide जम्बू.

जम्बूक (कः) 1. *m.* Vide जम्बूक.

जम्बूल(लः) 1. *m.* A plant (*Pandanus odoratissimus*); the rose-apple. *n.* Jokes or compliments to the bridegroom by female friends.

जम्बूल.मालिका (का) 1. *f.* Compliments to bride and bridegroom.

जम्भ (भः) 1. *m.* A tooth; a lime; food; the chin; a quiver; a portion; a demon.

जम्भक (कः) 1. *m.* A lime or citrón.

जम्भ.द्विष्(ट्) 5. *m.* A name of *Indra*.

जम्भ.मेदिन् (दी) 5. *m.* *Idem*.

जम्भर (रः) 1. *m.* A lime or citron.

जम्भल (लः) 1. *m.* *Idem*; a *Jaina*. (ला) *f.* A *Rākshasī*.

जम्भारि (रिः) 2. *m.* *Indra's* thunderbolt; fire or its deity; *Indra*.
