ज्ञ(ज्ञः) 1. *m.* A wise man ; *Brahmá* ; the moon ; *Buddha. a.* Knowing.

ज्ञप् ज्ञापयति 10. *a.* To know ; cause to know ; to whet ; beat, please.

ज्ञपित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Taught, made known, expounded.

ज्ञप्त (प्तः-प्ता-प्तं) *a.* Made known.

ज्ञप्ति (प्तिः) 2. *f.* Understanding.

ज्ञा(ग) जानाति जानोते 9. *c.* To know.

With अनु to assent to, acknowledge ; with अप to conceal ; with अव to despise ; with आ to command ; with प्र to know well ; with उष to deny knowing ; with परि to ascertain ; with प्रति or सं to assent to, promise ; with वि to discriminate ; with सं to recollect ; with प्रति and अभि to recognize. 10th. ज्ञान.पर (रः-रा-रं) *a.* Versed in knowledge or true wisdom.

ज्ञान.पूर्व्व (र्व्वः-र्व्वी-र्व्वं) *a.* Preceded by the acquirement of knowledge.

ज्ञानमय (यः-यो-यं) *a.* Consisting of or full of knowledge.

ज्ञान.सुद्र (द्रः-द्रा-द्रं) *a.* Having the impress of wisdom, wise ; making wise, imparting wisdom.

ज्ञान.सुल (लः-ला-लं) *a.* Founded in knowledge, or true wisdom.

ज्ञान.सूचण(णं-णा) 1. *f. n.* Indication ; sign or proof of knowledge.

ज्ञान.वत् (वान्-वतो-वत्) *a.* Wise.

ज्ञान.विज्ञान (नं) 1. *n.* Sacred and profane knowledge.

ज्ञानानुत्पाद (दः) 1. *m.* Ignorance.

ज्ञानावस्थित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Occupied in the acquisition of wisdom.
