- दासेर (रः) 1. *m.* A servant; fisherman; camel. *a.* Born of a slave.
- दास्य (स्यं) 1. *n.* Service.
- दाह (हः) 1. *m.* Burning; heat.
- दाहक (कः-का-कं) *a.* Burning. *m.* *Plumbago zeylanica*.
- दाह-ज्वर (रः) 1. *m.* Burning fever.
- दाहन (नं) 1. *n.* Burning.
- दाह-वत् (वान्-वती-वत्) *a.* On fire.
- दाह-सर (रः) 1. *m.* A place where dead bodies are burnt.
- दाह-हरण (णं) 1. *n.* The root of a fragrant grass (*Andropogon*).
- दाह्य (ह्यः-ह्या-ह्यं) *a.* Inflammable.
- दिक्क (कः) 1. *m.* A young elephant.
- दिक्कर (रः-री-रं) *a.* Young, juvenile. *f.* (री) A young woman.
