दिवा.सणि (णिः) 2. *m.* The sun.

दिवा.सध्य (धं) 1. *n.* Mid-day.

दिवा.रात्र (त्रं) 1. *n.* Day and night.

दिवा.रात्रि (त्रिः) 2. *f.* *Idem*.

दिवा.सुप्त(प्तः-प्ता-प्तं) *a.* Sleeping by day.

दिवि (विः) 2. *m.* The blue jay.

दिवि.ज (जः-जा-जं) *a.* Celestial.

दिवि.षट् (ट्) 5. *m.* A deity.

दिवि.ष्ठ (ष्ठः-ष्ठा-ष्ठं) *a.* Celestial.

दिवी (वी) 3. *f.* A sort of insect.

दिवोकस्(काः) 5. *m.* A deity; *chátaka*.

दिवोदास(सः) 1. *m.* *Divódása*, a king  
of Benares, and founder of a medical school.

दिवोद्भव(वः-वा-वं) *a.* Born or produced in heaven. *f.* Cardamoms.

दिवोकस् (काः) 5. *m.* A deity; *chátaka*; a deer; a bee; an elephant.

दिव्य(व्यः-व्या-व्यं) *a.* Divine, beautiful.  
*m.* Barley; bdellium; a divine property. *f.* Emblic myrobalan.  
*n.* Cloves; a sort of sandal; an ordeal; an oath.

दिव्य.कारिन् (री) 5. *m.* A man who undergoes an ordeal.

दिव्य.गन्ध (न्धः) 1. *m.* Sulphur. (न्धा)  
*f.* Cardamoms. *n.* (न्धं) Cloves.

दिव्य.गायन (नः) 1. *m.* A singer of heaven, a *Gandharba*.

दिव्य.दोहद (दः-दा-दं) *a.* Fit for an offering or oblation.

दिव्य.धर्म्मिन् (र्म्मिः-र्म्मिनी-र्म्मिः) *a.* Virtuous, good; agreeable.

दिव्य.पञ्चासृत (तं) 1. *n.* A mixture composed of *ghí*, curds, milk, butter and sugar.

दिव्य.रत्न (त्नं) 1. *n.* A fabulous gem.

दिव्य.रथ (थः) 1. *m.* The car or vehicle of any deity.

दिव्य.रस (सः) 1. *m.* Quicksilver.

दिव्य.वल्ल (ल्लं) 1. *m.* A kind of sunflower. *a.* Divinely clothed.

दिव्यादिया (या) 1. *f.* The heroine of a poem; a demi-goddess.

दिव्योष (षः) 1. *m.* A form of *Shiva*.

दिव्योदक (कं) 1. *n.* Rain; dew.

दिव्योपपादुक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Divine, celestial, of heavenly birth.

दिश् (श, ज, चै) दिशति, ते 6. *c.* To shew, to order, to command, to give. With अष to disguise; with आ to order, shew, summons; with उन्त् to proclaim, shew; with उप to advise; with निर to shew, speak aloud; with प्र to appoint; with सं to exhibit, to inform; with प्रति and सं to send back; with वि and अप to plead in excuse; with वि and निर् to declare; with सं and आ to allow; with सं and उप to point at with the finger.
