

- दु.भेद्य (द्यः-द्या-द्यं) *a.* Hard to be broken ; separated.
- दु.र्भति (तिः-तिः-ति) *a.* Foolish.
- दु.र्भनम् (नाः-नाः-नः) *a.* Sad, distressed, thinking sorrowfully.
- दु.र्भर (रः-रा-रं) *a.* Dying hard. *f.* Bent grass.
- दु.र्भलिका (का) 1. *f.* A farce.
- दु.र्भुख (खः-खा-खं) *a.* Scurrilous ; hideous. *m.* A monkey ; a serpent chief ; a horse ; a demon.
- दु.र्भूल्य (ल्यं) 1. *n.* A thing of worth.
- दु.र्भेषु (षाः-षाः-षः) *a.* Of little or contemptible understanding.
- दु.र्थीधन (नः) 1. *m.* The elder of the *Kuru* princes.
- दु.र्थीनि (निः-निः-नि) *a.* Of low origin.
- दु.र्लभ (भः-भा-भं) *a.* Difficult of attainment, dear. *m.* A plant (*Hedysarum*). *f.* Prickly nightshade.
- दु.र्वच (चः-चा-चं) *a.* Speaking ill, or with difficulty. *n.* Abuse.
- दु.र्वचस् (चः) 5. *n.* Abuse.
- दु.र्वर्ष (र्षं) 1. *n.* Silver ; a perfume. *a.* Of a bad class.
- दु.र्वर्षक (कं) 1. *n.* *Idem.*
- दु.र्वह (हः-हा-हं) *a.* Hard to be borne.
- दु.र्व्याच् (वाक्) *a.* An ill speaker, morally or physically. *f.* (चा) Abuse.
- दु.र्व्याच्य (च्यं) 1. *n.* Bad word ; censure.
- दु.र्व्याद (दः-दा-दं) *a.* One who speaks incorrectly or abusively.
- दु.र्व्यार (रः-रा-रं) *a.* Irresistible.
- दु.र्व्यासम् (साः) 5. *m.* Son of *Atri*. *a.* Badly dressed.
- दु.र्विध (धः-धा-धं) *a.* Poor ; wicked.
- दु.र्विनोत (तः) 1. *m.* A restive horse. *a.* Ill-mannered.
- दु.र्विभाव्य (व्यः-व्या-व्यं) *a.* Inconceivable, incomprehensible.
- दु.र्विवाह (हः) 1. *m.* A bad mode or form of marriage.
- दु.र्विषह (हः-हा-हं) *a.* Intolerable.
- दु.र्वृत्त (त्तः-त्ता-त्तं) *a.* Leading a low or infamous life.
- दु.र्वृत्ति (त्तिः) 2. *f.* Disreputable way of living ; juggling, fraud.
- दु.र्वृत्तन (नः-ना-नं) *a.* Hard to kill.
- दु.र्वृद्द (द्-त्) 5. *m.* An enemy. *a.* Inimical, ill-disposed.
- दु.र्वृद्दय (यः-या-यं) *a.* Evil-minded.
- दु.र्वृत्त (क) दोलनार्थि 10. *a.* To raise ; to excite ; to swing.
- दु.र्वृत्ति (त्तिः) 2. *m.* A *Muni* or sage. *f.* A small female tortoise.
- दु.र्वृत्त (रः-री-रं) *a.* Going with difficulty ; acting ill ; unattainable. *m.* A bivalve shell.
- दु.र्वृत्ति (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Behaving badly. *n.* Misbehaviour.
- दु.र्वृत्तन (र्त्तं) 5. *m.* A circumcised man ; one without a prepuce.
- दु.र्वृत्तित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Doing ill. *m.* Misconduct ; evil pursuit.
- दु.र्वृत्तन (नः) 1. *m.* *Indra*.
- दु.र्वृत्त (दः-दा-दं) *a.* Tattered.
- दु.र्वृत्तन (नः) 1. *m.* A *Kuru* prince.
- दु.र्वृत्त (य, इ, औ) दुष्कृति 4. *a.* To do or act wrong ; or be impure. With प्र and च्चा to become manifest or apparent.
- दु.र्वृत्त (रः-रा-रं) *a.* Hard to be done. *n.* Æther ; sky ; tree of abundance ; doing evil.
- दु.र्वृत्तन (र्त्तं) 5. *n.* Bad act ; sin.
