 नालीकिनी (नी) 3. *f.* A multitude or assemblage of lotus flowers.  
 नासो.व्रण (णः) 1. *m.* A fistulous or sinous sore, or wound.  
 नावमिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Ninth.  
 नाविक (कः) 1. *m.* The helmsman; a sailor. *a.* Belonging to a boat.  
 नाव्य (व्यः-व्या-व्यं) *a.* Navigable.  
 नाश(शः) 1. *m.* Annihilation; death; flight; desertion; elimination.  
 नाशन (नं) 1. *n.* Destruction.  
 नाशित (तः-ता-तं) *p.* Destroyed.
