 नैदाविक (कः-का-कं) *a.* Belonging to the summer season.
 नैद्र (द्रः-द्री-द्रं) *a.* Sleepy.
 नैधान (नः-नी-नं) *a.* Relating to treasure. *f.* Place of hid treasure.
 नैपाल (नः-नी-लं) *a.* Of *Nepál*. *f.* (ली) Double jasmine; red arsenic; Indigo; *Nyctanthes tristis*.
 नैपालिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Produced or brought from *Nepál*. *n.* Copper.
 नैपुण (णं) 1. *n.* Dexterity.

 नैयङ्गव (वः-वी-वं) *a.* Of deer's skin.

 नैल्य (ल्यं) 1. *n.* Blueness.
 नैविच्य (च्यं) 1. *n.* Compactness, thickness; continued sound.
 नैवेद्य (द्यं) 1. *n.* A religious offering.
 नैर्वाशक (कं) 1. *n.* A present to a *bráhma*n, as a girl, jewels, &c.
 नैश (शः-शी-शं) *a.* Nocturnal.
 नैश्चित्य (त्यं) 1. *n.* Certainty; fixed festival, as a marriage, &c.
 नैषध (धः) 1. *m.* *Nala*. *a.* Of *Nishadha*.
 नैष्करम्यं (रम्यं) 1. *n.* Neglect of works; salvation without works.
 नैष्कृतिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Worth 100 *Nishkas*, or bought with them.
 नैष्किक (कः) 1. *m.* A mint-master.
 नैष्कृतिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Wicked.
 नैष्ठिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Relating to state, office or condition; firm, fixed. *m.* A *bráhma*n who always lives with his tutor.
 नैष्ठुर्य्य (र्य्यं) 1. *n.* Cruelty.
 नैस्त्र्य (त्र्यं) 1. *n.* Dryness; coldness, disaffection. Also नैस्त्र्य
