पञ्चक (कः) 1. *m.* A cook.

पञ्चत् (चन्-चनो-चत्) *a.* Cooking.

पञ्चन(तः) 1. *m.* The sun ; fire ; India.

पञ्चतिंकल्प (ल्प-ल्पा-लंवं) *a.* Almost cooked or ripened.

पञ्चयुष्ट (उः) 1. *m.* A tree (*Hibiscus phœniceus*).

पञ्चन (नः) 1. *m.* Fire. *n.* Cooking.

पञ्चमान (नः-ना-नं) *a.* Cooking.

पञ्चम्यचा (चा) 1. *f.* A curcuma.

पञ्चि (चिः) 2. *m.* Fire ; cooking.

पञ्चेलिस (सः) 1. *m.* The sun ; fire. *a.* Fit to cook or ripen itself.

पञ्चेलुक (कः) 1. *m.* A cook.

पञ्चश् *adv.* By feet or stanzas.

पञ्चमान (नः-ना-नं) *p.* Being cooked.

पञ्ज (जः) 1. *m.* A *sudra*.

पञ्चक(कः-का-कं) *a.* Relating to five. *m.* A five. *n.* Field of battle.

पञ्चकपात्र (लः-सा-लं) *a.* Placed in in five cups or platters.

पञ्चकर्मन् (स्मी) 5. *n.* Five actions of the body, vomiting, evacuation by bleeding, or stool ; excretion or perspiring, blowing the nose.

पञ्चक्लेश *adv.* Five times.

पञ्चकोण (णः) 1. *m.* A pentagon.

पञ्चकोत्त (लं) 1. *n.* The aggregate of five spices combined.

पञ्चकोषा (षाः) 1. *m.* *plu.* The supposed five organs of the mind.

पञ्चखद् (हं-द्वौ) 1. *n.* 3. *f.* Five beds.

पञ्चगव (वं) 1. *n.* Five cows.

पञ्चगवधन (नः-ना-नं) *a.* Having the wealth of five cows.

पञ्चगथ (अं) 1. *n.* Five articles de-

rived from the cow ; milk, curds, butter, dung, and urine.

पञ्चगुण (एः-एा-एं) *a.* Five-fold.

पञ्चगुप्त (सः) 1. *m.* A tortoise ; system of the *Bauddhas*.

पञ्चगो (गौः-गौः-गु) *a.* Bought with five cows, worth five cows.

पञ्चचौर (रः) 1. *m.* A *Bauddha* sage.

पञ्चचूडा (डा) 1. *f.* A nymph.

पञ्चजन (नः) 1. *m.* Man ; name of a demon. *f.* (नो) Five persons.

पञ्चजनीन (नः) 1. *m.* An actor ; a buffoon ; a chief among five.

पञ्चज्ञान (नः) 1. *m.* A *buddha* teacher.

पञ्चतत्त्व (चं-क्षी) 1. *n.* 3. *f.* An assemblage of five carpenters.

पञ्चतत्त्व (त्वं) 1. *n.* Five elements.

पञ्चतन्मात्र (तं) 1. *n.* Five subtle substrata of the five elements.

पञ्चतपस् (पाः) 1. *m.* An ascetic exposed to four fires and the sun.

पञ्चतय (यः-या-यं) *a.* Having five parts or limbs ; five.

पञ्चता (ता-लं) 1. *f.* *n.* Death ; state or condition of five ; nature, or the five elements, viz. fire, air, earth, water, and æther.

पञ्चतीर्थी (थी) 3. *f.* Any five principal places of pilgrimage ; bathing on the day of the equinox.

पञ्चयु (युः) 2. *m.* Time ; cuckoo.

पञ्चदश (एः-ए०-एं) *a.* Fifteen or fifteenth. *f.* Full or new moon.

पञ्चदशन् (ए) *a.* Fifteen.

पञ्चदीर्घ (ईः) 1. *m.* Marks on five parts of the body, the arms, eyes, nose and breast.

पञ्चभा (धा) *adv.* In five ways.
