

पञ्चन् (ञ्च) *a.* Five.
 पञ्च.नख (खः) *l. m.* An elephant ; a tiger ; a tortoise.*f.*(खी)A lizard.
 पञ्च.नद (दः) *l. m.* The *Punjáb*.
 पञ्च.निम्ब(म्बं) *l. n.* Five parts of the *nimb* tree ; the flowers, fruit, leaves, bark, and root.
 पञ्चनी(नी) *3.f.* A chequered cloth for playing at draughts or chess.
 पञ्च.नीराजन (नं) *l. n.* Presenting a lamp, lotus, cloth, mango, and betel leaf to an idol, and bowing.
 पञ्च.पञ्च.नख(खः) *l. m.* Five kinds of animals that may be killed, the hare, the porcupine, the alligator, the rhinoceros and the tortoise.
 पञ्च.पञ्जव (वं) *l. n.* The sum of five sprouts ; the sprouts of the spondias, rose-apple, marmelos, citron, and wood apple combined.
 पञ्च.पर्णी^{र्णी} (णीं) *3. f.* A small shrub.
 पञ्च.पात्र (त्रं) *l. n.* Five plates collectively ; a *shrāddha*.
 पञ्च.प्रसाद(दः) *l. m.* A temple with four pinnacles and a steeple.
 पञ्च.प्राण(णः) *l. m plu.* Five vital airs.
 पञ्च.बन्ध(न्धः) *l. m.* A fine equal to the fifth part of any thing stolen.
 पञ्च.भद्र (द्रः) *l. m.* A horse with five auspicious spots or marks.
 पञ्च.भूत(तं) *l. n.* The five elements.
 पञ्च.भूतान्(तान्) *l. m.* Man as formed of the five elements.
 पञ्चम(मः-मी-मं) *a.* Fifth ; beautiful ; clever. *m.* A musical note.*f.*(मी) *Draupadī* ; a chequered cloth for chess ; the fifth day of the half month,

पञ्च.मकार (रं) *l. n.* Five essentials of the left hand *Tantra* ritual.
 पञ्चम.वत्(वान्-वतो-वत्) *a.* With five.
 पञ्च.महा.यज्ञ(ज्ञः) *l. m.* The five sacraments of the Hindus, viz. worshipping spirits by offerings of flowers ; primogenitors by obsequial rites ; gods by burnt-offerings ; *védas* by study ; and mankind by hospitality.
 पञ्च.भार (रः) *l. m.* Son of *Baladeva*.
 पञ्च.माषिक (कः-को-कं) *a.* Of five *māshas*, or worth five.
 पञ्चमास्य (स्यः) *l. m.* The cuckoo.
 पञ्चमिन् (मी-मिनी-मि) *a.* Aged five.
 पञ्च.सुख (खः) *l. m.* A name of *Shiva*.
 पञ्च.मुद्रा (द्रा) *l. f.* Five gestures made in offering to an idol.
 पञ्च.सूत्र (त्रं) *l. n.* Urine of the cow, goat, sheep, buffalo and ass.
 पञ्च.मूल (लं-लो) *l. n. 3. f.* The assemblage of five roots.
 पञ्च.यज्ञ(ज्ञः) *l. m.* Five ceremonies.
 पञ्च.रत्न(त्वं) *l. n.* Five precious gems or things, as gold, diamond, pearl, ruby and amethyst.
 पञ्च.रसा(सा) *l. f.* Emblic myrobalan.
 पञ्च.लक्ष्ण (णं) *l. n.* A *Purāna* or mythological poem.
 पञ्च.लवण(णं) *l. n.* Five kinds of salt.
 पञ्च.लाङ्गलक (कं) *l. n.* Gift of land requiring five ploughs.
 पञ्च.लोह (हं) *l. n.* A metallic alloy, containing five metals, viz. copper, brass, tin, lead and iron.
 पञ्च.वक्रा (क्रः) *l. m.* *Shiva* ; a lion.
 पञ्च.वट (टः) *l. m.* The brāhminical thread. (टी) Five trees.
