

वेद.सन्न्यास (सः) 1. *m.* Renouncing the ritual of the *Vedas*.  
 वेद.सन्न्यासिक (कः) 1. *m.* One who has renounced the *Vedas*.  
 वेद.सम्मत (तः-ता-तं) *a* Agreeable to the *Vedas*.  
 वेदाङ्ग (ङ्गः) 1. *m.* A sacred science ; a part of the *Vedas*. There are reckoned six : *Shikshá*, pronunciation ; *Kalpa*, ceremonies ; *Vyákarana*, grammar ; *Chhandas*, prosody ; *Jyotish*, astronomy ; and *Nirukti*, explanation of difficult parts of the *Vedas*.  
 वेदादि.वर्ण (र्ण) 1. *n.* The mystical name of God. [*Vedas*.  
 वेदाधिगम (मः) 1. *m.* Study of the वेदाध्ययन (नं) 1. *n.* *Idem*.  
 वेदाध्ययिन् (यी) 5. *m.* Student of the *Vedas*.  
 वेदाध्यापक (कः) 1. *m.* Teacher of the *Vedas*. [*Vedas*.  
 वेदाध्यापन (नं) 1. *n.* Explaining the वेदान्त (न्तः) 1. *m.* The metaphysico-theological doctrines of the *Vedas*, teaching the abstract worship of God ; name of a school of divinity or philosophy professing them.  
 वेदान्त.ग (गः) 1. *m.* A *Vedántist*.  
 वेदान्त.ज्ञ (ज्ञः) 1. *m.* *Idem*.  
 वेदान्तिन् (न्ती) 5. *m.* A follower of the *Vedánt* system.  
 वेदान्तोपगत (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Derived from the *Vedánt*.  
 वेदाभ्यास (सः) 1. *m.* The repetition of the mystical syllable *Oum* ; study of the *Vedas*.

वेदार (रः) 1. *m.* A chameleon, a lizard.  
 वेदि (दिः-दी) 2. 3. *f.* An altar ; seal ring. *m.* A pandit. *f.* (दिः) *Saraswati*.  
 वेदिका (का) 1. *f.* A quadrangular open shed in the middle of a court-yard ; an altar.  
 वेदि.जा (जा) 1. *f.* *Draupadí*, sister and wife of the *Pándus*.  
 वेदित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Made known.  
 वेदितव्य (व्य.-व्या-व्यं) *a.* Knowable or ascertainable.  
 वेदित् (ता-त्री-ढ) *a.* Wise, learned.  
 वेदित् (त्वं) 1. *n.* Knowledge, experience.  
 वेदिन् (दी-दिनी-दि) *m.* A pandit ; *Brahmá.n.* A plant (*Cissampelos*).  
 वेदीश (शः) 1. *Brahmá*. [*Vedas*.  
 वेदोक्त (क्तः-क्ता-क्तं) *a.* Declared in the वेदोदय (यः) 1. *m.* The sun.  
 वेदोदित (तः-ता-तं) *a.* Taught in the *Vedas*.  
 वेदोपकरण (णं) 1. *n.* A branch of the study of the *Vedas*.  
 वेद्य (द्यः-द्या-द्यं) *a.* That may or should be known, ascertained, or taught.  
 वेध (धः) 1. *m.* Perforation ; depth ; measure of time next to one *trutí*, 100 *trutis*.  
 वेधक (कः) 1. *m.* Camphor. *n.* Grain, rice in the ear. *a.* Piercing.  
 वेधन (नं) 1. *n.* Piercing ; depth. *f.* (नी) A piercer, a gimblet &c.  
 वेधनिका (का) 1. *f.* A pointed instrument for piercing ; an awl, gimblet.
