वैर.कार (रः) 1. *m.* A foe ; mischief-maker.

वैरत्न्य (त्न्ये) 1. *n.* Dislike, aversion.

वैर.ङ्कक (कः) 1. *m.* An ascetic, a devotee.

वै.घो (घीः-धीः-धि) *a.* At enmity.

वैर.निर्द्वानन (नं) 1. *n.* Revenge, retaliation.

वैर.प्रतिक्रिया (या) 1. *f.* *Idem.*

वैर श्रद्धि (दिः) 2. *f.* *Idem.*

वै.राग (गं) 1. *n.* Dis-affection ; absence of worldly passion or desire.

वै.रागिक (कः) 1. *m.* An ascetic of subdued passions.

वैरागिन् (गी) 5. *m.* *Idem* ; a religious mendicant.

वराय (यं) 1. *n.* Absence of worldly passion or desire.

वै.राट (टः) 1. *m.* An earth-worm.

वैराव्या (व्या) 1. *f.* One of the 16 *Vidyādevīs* or *Jainu* goddesses.

वैरानुबन्ध (न्धः) 1. *m.* State of enmity.

वैरानुबन्धिन् (न्धी) 5. *m.* *Vishnu* ; solar ray.

वैरायमाण (णः-ण-णं) *a.* Hostile.

वैरारोह (हः) 1. *m.* Desperate or arduous combat.

वैरिता (ता) 1. *f.* Enmity ; heroism.

वैरिन् (री-रिणो-रि) *m.* An enemy ; a hero. *a.* Hostile.

वैहृष्य (ष्यं) 1. *n.* Deformity.

वैरोचन (चः) 1. *m.* 3rd *Buddha* ; *Bali*, son of the sun ; a demigod.

वैरोचन.ानकेतन (नं) 1. *m.* *Pātāla*, the intermediate region between the earth and hell.

वैरोचनि (निः) 2. *m.* *Buddha* ; *Bali* ; son of the sun.

वरोचि (चिः) 2. *m.* The demon or *daitya Vanā*.

वैरोद्धार (रं) 1. *n.* Revenge.

वैकक्ष्य (क्ष्यं) 1. *n.* Difference.

वैकक्षा (क्ष्यं) 1. *n.* *Idem* ; contrariety ; reverse of the natural order ; absence of peculiarity.

वैल्व (ल्वः ल्वो-ल्वं) *n.* The fruit of the *Vilva* *a.* Belonging to the *Vilva* or *Ægle marmelos*.

वैल्वमय (यः-य-यं) *a.* Made of the *Vilva*.

वैवधिक (कः) 1. *m.* A chandler, vender of oil, grain, &c.

वैवर्ण्य (र्ण्यं) 1. *n.* Change of colour ; secession from caste ; heterogeneity.

वैवस्वत (तः) 1. *m.* *Yama* ; *Rudra* ; 7th *Manu* ; planet Saturn.

वैवाहिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Nuptial.

वैशद्य (द्यं) 1. *n.* Whiteness, purity.

वैशम्पायन (नः) 1. *m.* A sage, teacher of the *Yajur Veda*.

वैशस (सं) 1. *n.* Hindrance ; slaughter ; distress, cruelty.

वैशस्व (स्वं) 1. *n.* Government, rule ; state of being defenceless. *a.* Miserable.

वैशाख (खः) *m.* Name of a month (April-May) ; a churning stick. *n.* Attitude in shooting. *f.* (खी). Day of the full moon in the above month.

वैशारद (दः-दा-दं) *a.* Wise.
