

सोम.दैवत्य (त्यः-त्या-त्यं) *a.* Governed by the moon.

सोम.धारा (रा) 1. *f.* Sky.

सोमन् (मा) 5. *m.* The moon.

सोम.प (पः) 1. *m.* The performer of a sacrifice, or one that drinks the juice of the moon-plant.

सोम.पत्र (त्रः) 1. *m.* A sort of grass.

सोम.पा (पाः) 1. *m.* See सोमप.

सोम.पान (नं) 1. *n.* Drinking the juice of the moon-plant.

सोम.पीतिन् (तो) 5. *m.* See सोमप.

सोम वञ्चु (ञ्चुः) 2. *m.* The white esculent water-lily.

सोम.भू (भूः) 3. *m.* One of the *Vasudevas* of the *Jainas*; *Buddha*.

सोम.याग (गः) 1. *m.* Moon-plant offering.

सोम.याजिन् (जी) 5. *m.* See सोमप.

सोम.योनि (निः) 2. *m.* Yellow fragrant sandal.

सोम.राजिन् (जी) 5. *m.* A medicinal plant, *Serratula*.

सोमराजी (जी) 3. *f.* *Idem*.

सोम.खता (ता) 1. *f.* The moon-plant or acid *Asclepias*; the *Godāvari* river.

सोम.वंश (शः) 1. *m.* The lunar dynasty; *Yudhishthir*.

सोमवत् (वान्-वती-वत्) *a.* Lunar; having the *Asclepias* juice.

सोमवत् *adv.* Like the moon.

सोम.वल्क (क्तः) 1. *m.* A white kind of *Mimosa catechu*; also a medicinal plant. [plant.

सोम.वल्कि (रिः) 2. *f.* The moon-सोमवल्ली (ल्लो) 3. *f.* *Idem*; a twining plant; also a medicinal one.

सोम.वार (रः) 1. *m.* Monday.

सोम.विक्कचिन् (चो) 5. *m.* A vender of the juice of the *Asclepias*.

सोम.वृक्ष (क्षः) 1. *m.* A medicinal plant; a shrub, *Serratula*.

सोम.सञ्ज (ञ्जं) 1. *n.* Camphor.

सोम.सद् (द्) 1. *m.* A *pitri*, especially of the *Sādhyas*.

सोम.सिद्धान्त (न्तः) 1. *m.* One of the *Buddhas*; a system followed by some *Shaivas*.

सोम सिद्धान्तिन् (न्ती) 5. *m.* A follower of a branch of the *Shaivas*.

सोम.सिञ्चु (ञ्चुः) 2. *m.* *Vishnu*.

सोमसुत् (त्) 5. *m.* A sacrificer or priest who sprinkles *Asclepias* juice.

सोम.सुवा (ता) 1. *f.* The *Nerbudda*.

सोम.सुखत् (वान्-खती-खत्) *a.* Having drinkers of the *Soma* juice.

सोम.सुख (खं) 1. *n.* The red lotus.

सोम.सुख (खः-ख-खं) *a.* Soft, bland.

सोम.सुद्धवा (वा) 1. *f.* The *Nerbudda*.

सोम.सुष्टिक (कः) 1. *m.* A poison.

सोम.सुष्ट (ष्टः) 1. *m.* Irony, ridicule.

सोम.सुष्टन (नं) 1. *n.* *Idem*, apparent praise and covert censure.

सोम.कर (रः-रो-रं) *a.* Hoggish, swinish, belonging to a hog.

सोम.करिक (कः) 1. *m.* A hunter.

सोम.कर्य (र्यं) 1. *n.* Readiness; easy and extempore preparation of food or medicine; swinishness.

सोम.कुमार्य (र्यं) 1. *n.* Youthfulness; delicacy. [tility.

सोम.चय (चयं) 1. *n.* Minuteness, sub-
